Second Phase of Allotment to Professional Degree Courses - 2007

Candidates who have received allotment in the first phase to various Professional Degree Courses - 2007 have to ensure admission by reporting in the allotted colleges at the time and date prescribed, failing which their allotment and higher order options in the stream concerned will be cancelled.

All existing Higher Order Options of the candidates who have received allotment will be considered in the Second Phase of allotment and a consequent shift in allotment will be binding to the candidates. If candidates are completely satisfied with their allotted course/college as per, as per allotment published on 01.09.2007, and do not prefer a change in college/course, they have to cancel all their higher order options latest by 5 pm on 13.09.2007. Existing options available in the home page can be cancelled by typing the number '0' against the option and by clicking the 'update' button.

The second phase of allotment begins on 08.09.2007 (Saturday) and ends at 5 pm on 13.09.2007. Candidates have to visit the website "<http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in>" for re-arranging/deleting their higher order options, if necessary, during this period.

Candidates can also register options to the Self Financing colleges/courses mentioned below during this period. However allotment to these courses/colleges will be subject to the approval of the Central/State Government, Central/State Regulatory Bodies and affiliation by the Universities concerned.

- I. **4 Medical Colleges, 6 Dental Colleges, One Ayurveda College, 16 Pharmacy Colleges, 15 Nursing Colleges and 2 MLT Colleges.**
- II. (a) **B.Sc. Nursing (Ayurveda) and B.Pharm (Ayurveda) Courses of the Parassinikadavu Ayurveda Medical College.**
 - (b) **Civil Engineering (CE) Course in P A Aziz College of Engineering, Thiruvananthapuram.**
 - (c) **Bio Medical Engineering (BM) and Food Technology (FT) Courses in TKM Institute of Technology, Ezhukone, Kollam.**

(d) Mechanical Engineering (ME) and Electrical & Electronics Engineering (EE) in IES College of Engineering, Chittilappilly, Thrissur.

The details of these courses/colleges are available in the website "<http://www.cee-kerala.org>". The fee applicable to these courses will be the fee fixed by the Fee Regulatory Committee. The fee for **B.Sc. Nursing (Ayurveda)** course will be **Rs. 25,000/-** and for **B.Pharm (Ayurveda)** course will be **Rs. 29,300/-**.

Those candidates who have not registered any options till date can also register options to the above mentioned courses. Others can also add these options to their existing option list and may re-arrange them based on their order of preference.

Candidates who are not interested in giving fresh options to these courses may re-arrange/delete their higher order options, if necessary.

The Second Allotment will be published on **18.09.2007 (Tuesday)**.
