## Amendment to the prospectus for admission to Professional Degree Courses- 2007

I. After clause 15.2.1 the following will be added:-

(A) The 50% seats to be allotted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations in Private Self-financing Engineering colleges covered by the agreement other than those having minority benefits will be distributed among the various categories as follows:-

II. After clause 15.2.2, the following will be added:-

15.2.2 (A) Twenty percent of the total seats set apart for the Government for allotment in Private Self-financing Engineering institutions established by minority communities will be allotted to candidates belonging to the minority community to which the management of the College / Institution belongs. The remaining eighty percent of the seats will be allotted as per the provisions in clause 15.2.1 (A)

15.2.2 (B) In the case of Dr Somervell Memorial CSI Medical College, Karakonam, Thiruvananthapuram, these 20% seats to be allotted to the candidates of concerned minority communities will be distributed in the ratio 4:1 among SIUC of the South Kerala Diocese and converts from Scheduled Castes to Christianity (SIUC) of the South Kerala Diocese.

**Note:** Candidates belonging to these categories applying to the above institutions shall also produce community certificate from the competent authority of the SIUC of South Kerala Diocese/parish.

III. The percentage distribution of seats to be allotted by the CEE under various categories as explained under 15.3.2 stands modified as follows:

The clause 15.3.2 (a) to (e) mentioned in clause 15.3.4 shall be read as 15.3.2 (II) to (VII)

#### IV. Caution Deposit

For Clause 15.4.1, the following shall be substituted:

All candidates except those belonging to SC/ST/OEC categories will have to remit caution deposit at the rates mentioned below:

- (a) For MBBS /BDS Courses: A maximum of Rs.10,000/-
- (b) For Engineering Course in Private Self Financing Colleges: A maximum of Rs. 10,000/-
- (c) For all other courses: A maximum of Rs. 5,000/-

For SC/ST/OEC candidates: Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC categories will have to remit provisional Caution Deposit at the rates existing in Government Colleges and applicable to the course to which the candidate is allotted as a token of having accepted the allotment.

**Note:** *The difference in the amount of Caution deposit applicable to Private Self financing Engineering Colleges at the rates mentioned above, in case of SC/ST /OEC candidates will be paid by the Government.*

After clause 15.4.2 (b), the following may be added

(c) The tuition fee and Interest Free Refundable Deposit (IFRD) in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC categories will be paid by the Government.

15.4.2 Mode of payment of Tuition Fee, Caution Deposit and Interest Free Refundable Deposit (IFRD).

- (c) For all candidates for seats set apart for the Government in all B.Tech courses in private self-financing colleges the annual tuition fee payable is Rs. 15,450/- and the one time IFRD payable is Rs. 1.5 lakhs
- (d) The clause 15.4.1 (ii) mentioned in clause 15.4.2(b) shall be read as 15.4.1(ii) (A).

#### V. Lapsed Seats

The following may be added as clause 17.1

The Private self-financing engineering colleges are entitled to fill those seats still remaining unfilled after 5.00 PM on 5<sup>th</sup> September 2007 and the Private Self-financing Medical colleges are entitled to fill those seats after 5.00 PM on 25<sup>th</sup> September 2007. The prospectus for admission to professional degree courses Kerala stands modified accordingly.
