**Sub: - Entrance Examination for admission to Engineering courses,
Kerala, 2007– Results – published.**

The result of the Entrance Examination for admission to the **ENGINEERING COURSES**, Kerala, 2007, is published herewith.

The result has been prepared on the basis of the Entrance Examination conducted on 23rd (Physics & Chemistry) and 24th (Mathematics) April 2007 and is published district-wise, in roll-order (with Rank). Candidates will have to refer to the list corresponding to the district in which they have appeared for the Entrance Examination. The result of 117 candidates have been withheld (WHELD) on various grounds. Candidates who have not appeared for both the Papers in the Engineering Entrance Examination and of those who have secured less than 10 marks (with exception of SC/ST candidates and those candidates eligible for SC/ST benefits) in at least one paper of the examination have been 'Disqualified' (DQLFD).

The results will be published through media. It will be available at the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and in the web-sites, www.keralaresults.nic.in and www.results.kerala.nic.in from 11 am today.

The Answer Keys were published on 26.4.2007. A few complaints regarding the keys have been received and the same have been examined by 'Expert Committees' constituted for the purpose. Based on the recommendations of the Committees, the following modifications have been made in the answer keys published on 26.4.2007.

Accordingly, in Paper I (Physics & Chemistry), two (2) questions in Physics and three (3) questions in Chemistry have been deleted. These five (5) questions have not been included in the valuation and no marks have been awarded for these deleted questions to any candidate. Valuation has been based on 70 questions in Physics and 45 questions in Chemistry. The marks obtained in Physics part and Chemistry part of Paper I have been multiplied by $(72/70)$ and $(48/45)$ respectively to get the actual marks (corrected to four places of decimals) in determining the marks for Paper I. No question has been deleted from valuation in Paper II (Mathematics). The above formula is applied to award proportionate marks based on the score of the candidate for the questions considered for evaluation (excluding deleted questions) to compensate the loss of marks for the deleted questions.

Valuation is computerized and is error-free. There is no provision for revaluation of answer scripts or rechecking of marks.

The results of candidates belonging to SC/ST categories and those claiming SC/ST benefits, whose community claims have not been cleared by the Screening Committee, have been withheld.

The inclusion of the Roll No. of any candidate in this list does not entitle him/her for admission unless he/she satisfies all the conditions of eligibility as prescribed in the Prospectus. The category/community-wise list based on the rank list will also be published in due course. Complaints regarding the Category List should reach the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations within 15 days after the publication of the category list.

Candidates will be admitted to the courses only if the academic eligibility conditions as prescribed in the Prospectus are fulfilled at the time of Allotment Process. This will be verified at the time of admission.

Separate Notification for Allotment Process for allotment of courses/colleges will be issued in due course. [See Prospectus 2007].
