ORDER

Government have discussed the matter of allotment of seats and fee to be levied with the management of the Self Financing Ayurveda / Siddha Colleges and an agreement has been executed with them for the admissions for the academic year 2008-09.

2. Sanction is accorded to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations for including the following Self Financing Ayurveda / Siddha Colleges, who have entered into agreement with Government in respect of the principle of allotment, sharing of seats and fee structure for allotment of students to BAMS / BSMS Courses for the year 2008-09 subject to the terms and conditions specified below: -

3. Terms and Conditions: -

1. 50% of the seats in the private Self Financing Colleges will be filled up from the list of students qualified in the Common Entrance Test conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations with merit and applying the principles of reservation in Government Colleges.
2. The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations will ensure that allotments to all seats as above are filled up by allotting students from the list before 31.8.2008.
3. The fee for the above 50% seats will be 35,000/- (Rupees Thirtyfive Thousand only) per annum. Annual tuition fee for the candidates belonging to SC/ST, OEC/ those candidates eligible for educational monitory / benefits as per G.O.(Ms)No.25/05/SCSTDD dated 26.6.2005, students will be paid by Government at the rate of Rs.35,000/-.
4. 35% of the total seats in the Colleges will be filled up by the Management from the candidates satisfying the academic eligibility conducted as per the prospectus 2008-09 and qualified in the Medical entrance examinations conducted by the Commissioner of Entrance Examinations. The admission will be on the basis of the merit list prepared according to the percentage of marks obtained for the optional subjects in the qualifying examinations from among the applications received by the Member Colleges.
5. The fee collected from the students as above in item No.4 will be Rs.90,000/- (Rupees Ninety Thousand only).
6. The remaining 15% seats will be filled up by the Management from the eligible students, who are children or dependents of Non-Resident Indians. The fees collected from such students will be Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs only) per annum.
7. As per the agreement. the management they will not receive cash or kind other than the fee specified.
8. The said agreement will be submitted by the Government before the Admission Supervisory Committee, Fee Regulatory Committee and also before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India for approval.
9. The member colleges of Kerala State Indian Systems of Medicine Self financing College Management Association will be entitled to collect uniform fee not exceeding Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only), which is the fee fixed by the Fee Regulatory Committee in the State from all students excluding those admitted under NRI quota, if the agreement is not approved by the Court or any other competent authority to declare so.

10. In the case of any further litigation the above terms and conditions will be subject to the court of law.
