ORDER

Government have discussed the matter of allotment of seats and fee to be levied with the management of the Self Financing Nursing Colleges and an agreement has been executed with them for the admissions for the year 2008-09.

2. Sanction is accorded to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations for including the following Self Financing Nursing Colleges, who have entered into agreement with Government in respect of the principles of allotment, sharing of seats and fee structure for allotment of students to B. Sc Nursing Course for the year 2008-09, subject to the terms and conditions specified below: -

Terms and Conditions:

- 1) 50% of the seats in the private/self financing professional Colleges will be filled up from the list of students qualified in the Common Entrance Test conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations with merit and applying the principles of reservation in Government Colleges.
- 2) 20% of the above seats in the Institutions having minority status will be filled up from the list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations from the students belonging to the community, which established the member college. Candidates claiming such reservation should produce community certificate from the Village Officer before the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- 3) The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations will ensure that allotments to all seats as above are filled up by allotting students from the list before **31.8.2008**.
- 4) The fee for the above 50% seats will be **Rs.40,000/-** (Rupees Forty Thousand only) per annum. Annual tuition fee for candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC, the students eligible for education minority status as per G.O.(MS)No.25/05/STSCDD dated 20.06.2005 will be paid by Government at the rate of Rs.40,000/-. The candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC shall not remit the tuition fee during the allotment process. However, such candidates have to remit an amount of **Rs.100/-** as a token for accepting the allotment.
- 5) 35% of the total seats in the Colleges will be filled up by the Management from the candidates satisfy the academic eligibility condition as per the prospectus 2008 and qualified in the medical entrance examinations conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. The admission will be on the basis of the merit list prepared according to the percentage of marks obtained for the optional subjects in the qualifying examinations from among the applications received by the Member Colleges.
- 6) The fee collected from the students as above in item No.5 will be **Rs.78,000/-** (Rupees Seventy Eight Thousand only).

- 7) The remaining 15% seats will be filled up by the Management from the eligible students, who are children or dependents of Non-Resident Indians. The fee to be collected from such students will be **Rs.2,00,000/-** (Rupees Two Lakhs only) per annum.
 - 8) As per the agreement, the management will not receive cash or kind other than the fee specified.
 - 9) The said agreement will be submitted by the Government before the Admission Supervisory Committee, Fee Regulatory Committee and also before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India for approval.
 - 10) The member colleges will be entitled to collect uniform fee not exceeding Rs.59,000/- (Rupees Fifty Nine Thousand only), which is the fee fixed by the Fee Regulatory Committee in the State from all students excluding those admitted under NRI quota, if the agreement is not approved by the Court or any other competent authority to declare so.
 - 11) The students admitted from 01.09.2008 till closing of admission by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations are not bound to pay liquidated damages.
3. In the case of any further litigations, the above terms and conditions will be subject to the Court of Law.
