ALLOTMENT TO PROFESSIONAL DEGREE COURSES 2009

[G.O.(Ms)No.85/2009/H,Edn., Dated, Thiruvananthapuram, 06.07.2009]

The activities related to the allotment to Professional Degree Courses for the year 2009-10 will commence on **07.07.2009** (Tuesday).

Candidates included under various rank lists can register their options on the Website www.cee.kerala.gov.in/keam from 1 pm on **07.07.2009** to 1 pm on **14.07.2009**. Candidates who do not register their options will not be considered for allotment under any circumstances. The “Option Facilitation Centres” [OFC] and “Help Desks” [HD], having internet facility, will be functioning through out the State during this period for registration of options by the candidates. The Students who are allotted to Private Self financing Engineering colleges during the second phase of allotment will not be eligible for any other higher options.

The Candidates who are allotted to Private Self financing Engineering Colleges, but do not seek admission will get the refund of fees. The candidates who get admission in these types of colleges can cancel their admission till 14th August, and the fee remitted at the Bank will be refunded to them. However, if they cancel their admission after 14th August, they will have to remit the entire course fee in order to get the TC and other documents from this college.

The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations will be making allotment to the various Professional courses in the following Colleges:

- 1) Government/Government-Aided Colleges & colleges under Kerala Agricultural University (KAU).

(*Options will be invited against the Self-financing Medical/Dental /Ayurveda Colleges which have not received the necessary sanction from the Government of India. Such institutions may be included for allotment subject to their getting approval from Government of India)

Mandatory Reservation : Leaving the seats set apart for All India Quota, Government of India Nominees, Special reservation, Persons with Disabilities and Management, the remaining Government seats for each course in Govt./Aided/KAU Colleges will be distributed as per the mandatory reservation principle as contemplated in G.O. (P) 208/66/Edn. Dated 2.5.1966, G.O. (Ms) No. 95/08/SCSTDD Dated 06.10.2008 and as modified from time to time.

The percentage break-up of seats as per mandatory reservation is as follows:

The existing reservation policy in Government, Government Aided Colleges and Colleges under KAU will be continued. The seat reservation policy and fee structure applicable to other self-financing institutions will be as follows:

Professional Colleges	Government seats	Reservation of seats
1. Self-financing Engineering colleges under the control of Government/ Universities.	50%	As applicable in Govt. / Govt-Aided Colleges
2. Private self-financing institutions except those having 'Minority status'		

Note:(1) In the case of the Private Self-financing institutions recognized as 'Minority Institutions', out of the 50% Government seats, 20% will be allotted to eligible candidates belonging to the Minority Community which runs the college, on the basis of merit. In such institutions, the remaining Government seats will be allotted by the CEE as per the reservation pattern applicable in Govt./Govt.-Aided Colleges. (See Annexure VI)

(2) In the case of Self-financing Engineering Colleges under Government control and in Selffinancing Engineering Colleges under Kerala, Mahatma Gandhi and Calicut Universities, 35% of the seats under Management quota also will be allotted by the CEE. The CEE will allot only 25% of the seats under Management quota, in the case of SCT College of Engineering, Pappanamcode, Thiruvananthapuram. Allotment to these seats will be strictly on the basis of merit.

Annexure VIII

The details of fee concession in Private self financing Medical/Dental colleges

As per the agreement arrived at between the Government and the Managements of Private Self-financing Medical Colleges, the Managements have agreed to grant the benefits of fee concession to BPL candidates / candidates having low annual

family income, up to a maximum of 14% of those allotted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE) and to students belonging to SEBC category, up to a maximum of 26% of those allotted by the CEE in each institution.

- a) 14% of candidates, from among those allotted by the CEE in each Private Self financing Medical/Dental College, who are BPL/ having lower family income, irrespective of rank or category, can avail the benefits of fee concession. However SC/ST/OEC category of candidates, who already enjoy fee concession benefit, will not be considered for this purpose.
- b) 26% of candidates, who have been allowed SEBC status by the CEE, whether they are admitted under merit quota, reservation category or minority community category in each institution, can avail the benefits of fee concession. They will be selected on the basis of the rank.
- c) The same principle as explained in clauses (a) and (b) is applicable to the minority institutions also.

The fee benefits will be granted only after the closure of allotments to Private Self-financing Medical/Dental Colleges. Hence candidates allotted to these institutions will have to remit the state merit fee at the time of allotment. The CEE will refund the balance amount to the candidates who are eligible for fee benefits after the completion of allotment process.

The details of fee concession in Government Controlled Self financing Medical /Dental Colleges:

Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram, Kannur/Cooperative Medical College Kochi
Pariyaram Dental College Kannur

- a) 10 candidates, from among those allotted by the CEE in each Medical College and 6 candidates from among those allotted by the CEE in the Dental College, who are BPL/ having lower family income, irrespective of rank or category, can enjoy the benefits. However SC/ST/OEC category of candidates, who already enjoy fee concession benefit, will not be considered for this purpose.
- b) 13 candidates, from among those allotted by the CEE for MBBS, and 8 candidates from among those allotted by the CEE for BDS who have been allowed SEBC status, whether they are admitted under merit quota or reservation category in each institution, can enjoy the benefits of fee concession. They will be selected on the basis of the rank.

The fee benefits will be granted only after the closure of allotments to MBBS/BDS Courses. Hence candidates allotted to these institutions will have to remit the state merit fee at the time of allotment. The CEE will refund the balance amount to the candidates who are eligible for fee benefits after the completion of allotment process.
