### Abstract

Higher Education Department – Fee Concession under Lower Income Group - Fixation of Fee – Clarification - Orders issued.

### ORDER

In the G.O read as first paper above, Government have *interalia* ordered that 25% Lower Income Group candidates will be eligible to study B-Tech Course for a Tuition Fee of Rs.35,000/- (Rupees Thirty Five Thousand only) and for other 25%, Tuition Fee will be Rs.35,000/- + Rs.25,000/- as Special Fee. The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations in his letter read as second paper above, has informed Government that in certain Self financing Engineering colleges, seats under Merit Quota are vacant and has requested Government to clarify the Fee under Lower Income Group in respect of students who got admission based on the allotment made by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations:

2. Government have examined the case in detail and order that regarding the Fee Concession under the Lower Income Group, Tuition Fee is fixed as Rs. 35,000/- (Rupees Thirty Five Thousand only) for 50% of the total number of students actually allotted in each stream under Merit Quota. For the remaining 50% of the students under Merit Quota, the Fee will be Rs.60,000/- (Rs.35,000/- as Tuition Fee + Rs.25,000/- as Special Fees).

3. It is further clarified that, if the total number of students admitted under Merit Quota is 20, Fee of ten students from the Lower Income Group will be Rs.35,000/- (Rupees Thirty Five Thousand only) and for others, it will be Rs.60,000/- . If the total number of students under Merit quota is 21, for 11 students, the Fee will be Rs.35,000/- (Rupees Thirty Five Thousand only). For the remaining ten students it will be Rs.60,000/-.

4. The Government order cited above stands modified to this extend.
