ORDER

Government have issued orders regarding the allotment of seats and fees for MBBS and BDS courses during 2012-2013 in the institutions under the Kerala Christian Professional College Managements' Federation and Dr.Somervell Memorial CSI Medical College, Karakonam after entering into consensual agreements with the Managements as per the Government Orders read as 1st and 2nd above respectively.

As per the agreements every management under the Kerala Christian Professional College Managements' Federation and the Management of Dr.Somervell Memorial CSI Medical College, Karakonam will set apart a sum of ₹ 40,00,000/- (Rupees Forty Lakhs only), for a batch of 100 MBBS students in the case of Medical Colleges and ₹14,00,000/- (Rupees Fourteen Lakhs only) for a batch of 50 BDS students in the case of Dental Colleges, to be provided as Scholarship in the form of tuition fee waiver to students from Below Poverty Line (BPL) families, other financially poor and the marginalized. It was also mentioned that the criteria for selection of BPL /other financially poor and the marginalized will be specified by Government.

Government have examined the whole aspects in detail and are pleased to issue the following orders for the disbursement of Scholarship fund to

BPL /other financially poor and the marginalized students studying in the institutions under the Kerala Christian Professional College Managements' Federation and Dr.Somervell Memorial CSI Medical College, Karakonam during 2012-2013.

1. BPL category will be fixed an annual income limit at par with Socially and Economically Backward Classes (SEBC) categories and only those students having an annual income below ₹ 4,50,000/- (Rupees Four Lakh Fifty Thousand only) will be selected for scholarship under this category limiting their number to 7 (Seven) for a batch of 100 MBBS seats.
2. The BPL category Students (7 Nos. for 100 MBBS Seats) and Socially and Economically Backward Classes (SEBC) Categories (13 Nos. for 100 MBBS Seats) shall be divided into two Groups, viz; Group 'A' and Group 'B', each containing 10 students. Under Group 'A', the BPL and SEBC students having an annual income not exceeding ₹ 1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) shall be included and under Group 'B' the BPL and SEBC students having an annual income above ₹ 1 Lakh and below ₹ 4.5 Lakh shall be included.
3. The Scholarship amount of ₹ 40,00,000/- (Rupees Forty Lakh only), for a batch of 100 MBBS students shall be distributed in the following rate among the two groups.

Group A - ₹ 25 Lakh @ ₹ 2.5 Lakh for each student

Group B - ₹ 15 Lakh @ ₹ 1.5 Lakh for each student
4. If the number of students under Group 'A' exceeds Ten (10), then the 10 students will be selected on the basis of lowest income below ₹ 1 Lakh and scholarship shall be given @ ₹ 2.5 Lakh, limiting the total number of scholarships under this category to 10 (Ten).
5. The BPL and SEBC students under Group 'B' having income above ₹ 1 Lakh and below ₹ 4.5 Lakh along with the remaining students if any

under Group 'A' after selection as per item No.4 above, shall be given scholarship @ ₹ 1.5 Lakh without limiting their number to 10 (Ten), but without exceeding the total number of students under Group 'A' and 'B' together, which is 20 (Twenty).

6. Students selected under Government Merit quota alone are eligible for the aforesaid scholarship.
7. The excess fund if any after providing scholarships as aforesaid shall be kept in the Scholarship account of the institution concerned as Corpus fund which will be utilised by Government at their discretion for providing scholarship to the needy students studying in these institutions.

The orders regarding the criteria for selection of the disbursement of Scholarship fund for BDS course in these institutions will be issued separately.
