FILLING UP OF VACANT SEATS IN BDS COURSES-2015
ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED

The online allotment to fill up the vacant BDS seats in Government Dental College, Thrissur and a Private Self Financing Dental College (Kannur Dental College, Anjarakandy, Kannur) in Kerala is published herewith on the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. One of the seats reserved for Nominees in Government Medical College, Kozhikkode has been reported as vacant and allotment is given to the eligible candidate as per the online options available and following the conditions of Spot Admission. The consequent vacancy created in Government Dental College, Kozhikkode has also been filled up as above.

The details of allotment of a candidate such as Name, Roll Number, Allotted Course, Allotted College, Category of Allotment, Fee details etc. will be available on the home page of the candidate. The candidates should take a printout of the allotment memo pertaining to the vacancy filling phase for BDS course and produce it before the authorities of State Bank of Travancore (SBT) for payment of fee/balance fee. The list of designated branches of SBT is available on the website.

Those candidates who receive an allotment afresh should remit the fees to be paid to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as specified in the allotment memo at any of the designated branches of State Bank of Travancore on 30.09.2015 and should join the course/college allotted before 5 pm on 30.09.2015.

The candidates who get a change in allotment than that of the previous allotment should pay the balance fee, if applicable, in a designated branch of SBT on 30.09.2015 and should join the course/college allotted as per the allotment memo before 5 pm on 30.09.2015.

Those candidates who do not join the course/college allotted within the stipulated time will lose their allotment and are liable to pay the liquidated damages as given below.

Important:- This will be the last allotment to the above colleges unless otherwise notified and hence the candidates who get allotments in this phase should invariably join the allotted colleges. Otherwise they are liable to pay the Liquidated damages of Rs. 10 lakhs as envisaged under Clause 12.2.4 of the Prospectus for KEAM-2015.

The Allotment and Admission in the above colleges shall be subject to the result of the Writ Petitions pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala.

The candidates getting allotment are liable to remit the fee fixed by the Fee Regulatory Committee if the fee fixed on the basis of agreement between Government and Self-financing Managements is not approved by the Hon'ble Court or any competent authority.

Note: Candidates admitted in Govt./ Govt. Controlled Self Financing Engineering Colleges can accept the new allotment to BDS Course only after paying the liquidated damages as per clause 12.2.4 of the Prospectus-2015 and orders issued by the Government.

Candidates admitted in Private Self Financing Engineering Colleges under Kerala Catholic Engineering College Managements Association can accept the new allotment to BDS Course subject to the conditions in GO(Ms) No. 252/2014/H.Edn. Dated: 07.06.2014.

The Candidates admitted in other Private Self Financing Engineering/Architecture Colleges who are allotted to Medical & Allied courses through KEAM 2015 need not pay the Liquidated Damages as per GO(Ms) No. 372/2015/H.Edn. Dated: 03.07.2015 and GO(Ms) No.378/2015/H.Edn. Dated: 03.07.2015 for getting Transfer Certificate and other Documents. But the fees remitted for the year shall not be refunded.
