ONLINE ALLOTMENT TO FILL UP THE VACANT SEATS IN MBBS/BDS COURSES AND TO THE NEWLY INCLUDED MEDICAL/DENTAL COLLEGES-2016

ONLINE OPTION CONFIRMATION IS MANDATORY

The vacant seats in MBBS and BDS courses in Govt/Govt Controlled Self Financing/Private Self Financing Medical/Dental colleges and the Government seats available in the newly included Medical/Dental colleges will be filled up through an online allotment which will be published on 18.09.2016. The Candidates who want their higher order options to be considered in this vacancy filling phase of allotment shall have to login to their Home Page and confirm their options by clicking the 'Confirm' button available therein. After Online Option Confirmation, the candidates can re-arrange /delete their higher order options and also **register fresh options to the newly added Courses/Colleges** from 16.09.2016 to 18.09.2016, 1 pm, through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. **Those who do not confirm their options online will not be considered for this allotment and also their higher options in MBBS/BDS courses will not be available in the subsequent online allotments.** However his/her existing allotment shall be retained.

On the basis of options received up to 1 pm on 18.09.2016, the vacancy filling phase of allotment to MBBS/BDS courses will be published in the evening on 18.09.2016. Candidates who receive allotment shall have to take a printout of their allotment memo and remit the fee/ balance fee payable to the CEE, in one of the designated branches of the State Bank of Travancore (SBT) or by way of online payment on 19.09.2016 or 20.09.2016. The list of designated branches of SBT is available on the website. After remitting the fee/balance fee, the candidates should join the course/college before 5 pm on 20.09.2016. Those candidates who do not remit the fee/balance fee and who do not join the course/college allotted within the stipulated time will lose their allotment and also their existing higher options under MBBS/BDS courses.

The schedule for allotment is given below:

16.09.2016	Website opens for Online Option Confirmation and for enabling re-arrangement / deletion of higher options and registration of fresh options to the newly added Medical/Dental Colleges.
18.09.2016 (1 pm)	Time for Online Option Confirmation and re-arrangement/deletion/ addition of options ends
18.09.2016 (8 pm)	Publication of Allotment
19.09.2016 & 20.09.2016	Candidates who receive allotment should remit the fee /balance fee payable in SBT or by way of online payment and should report before the college authorities to join the allotted college/course.
20.09.2016, 5.30 pm	All the college authorities should approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS).

* This fee concession benefit will be available to the candidates only after completion of allotment process. Hence candidates should remit the full fee at the time of allotment. Balance fee will be refunded to the candidates.

Token Deposit :

Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC Community category and those having benefit as per G.O.(MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005, have to remit token deposit of Rs. 1000/- as token of having accepted the allotment.

This allotment is for filling up the vacant seats in only MBBS/BDS courses and the allotments to other Medical & Allied courses will be notified in due course.

The candidates getting allotment are liable to remit the fee fixed by the Fee Regulatory Committee if the fee fixed on the basis of agreement between Government and Self-financing Managements is not approved by the Hon'ble Court or any competent authority.

Note: Candidates admitted in Govt./ Aided/ Govt. Controlled Self Financing Engineering Colleges can accept the new allotment to Medical & Allied Courses only after paying the liquidated damages as per clause 12.2.4 of the Prospectus-2016 and orders issued by the Government.

Candidates admitted in Private Self Financing Engineering Colleges under Kerala Catholic Engineering College Managements Association can accept the new allotment to Medical & Allied Courses subject to the conditions in GO(Ms) No.252/2014/H.Edn.Dated: 07.06.2014.

While issuing Transfer Certificate and other documents to the candidates admitted in other Private Self Financing Engineering/Architecture colleges consequent to the allotment through KEAM 2016, liquidated damages shall not be collected as per GO(Ms) No.155/2016/H.Edn. Dated: 30.06.2016 and GO(Rt) No.1686/2016/H.Edn.Dated: 30.06.2016. But the fees remitted for the year need not be refunded.
