3. Consensual Agreement dated 06.09.2016 entered into between the Pariyaram Medical College, Under Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram, Kannur District and the Joint Secretary to Government, Health & Family Welfare Department, Government Secretariat.

ORDER

As per Government order read as 1st paper above, Government have approved the fee structure pertaining to the MBBS course in the Pariyaram Medical College, Under Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram, Kannur for allotment of students to MBBS course for the academic year 2016-17. As per the letter read as 2nd paper above, the Vice Principal, Pariyaram Medical College, Under Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram, Kannur District has requested Government to execute a consensual agreement based on the above Government order with specific terms and conditions.

In the circumstances, Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction to include Pariyaram Medical College in the list of self-financing medical colleges for allotment from the list of students prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Kerala for the academic Year 2016-17 subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. 50% of the total seats in the Medical College, Academy of Medical Sciences will be filled up by the Government from the list prepared by the Commissioner of Entrance Examinations in accordance with merit and reservation principles followed by Government from time to time.
2. The Government shall furnish the list of the students to be admitted in the college by the management concerned and the management concerned shall admit the students specified in the list. The students in the list will be given specific instruction as to the date and time of presentation before the college for admission, the amount of fees to be paid and the records to be submitted at the time of admission. The management concerned shall admit

the students who have complied with the instructions as certified by the Government. The Government shall furnish such lists on or before the day of 20.09.2016.

3. If any student is not admitted by the management concerned for specific defects or for any reason whatsoever, it shall intimate the Government the defects or reasons as the case may be and the Government shall rectify the defects or state the reasons for accepting the list or furnish a revised list which the management concerned shall accept and admit the student accordingly following the above procedures but in any case not later than 5.00 PM on 20.09.2016. The management concerned shall be entitled to fill those seats remaining unfilled by government after the cutoff date for admission to government merit quota seats for the academic year 2016-17.
4. The Management concerned shall be entitled to collect annual fees at the following concessional rates from the students admitted under the 50% Government Merit quota during the entire course period.

a	Students belonging to BPL family as per State Government norms (10 students)	25000/-
b	If there are not enough candidates as in (a) above candidates with the lower annual family income, based on income certificates to be produced from competent authority; but the total number not exceeding 10 that is, 20% of the total seats allotted by the Government, for both a & b together.	
c	Candidates who have got admission under SEBC reservation categories (13 students)	45000/-
d	Candidates who have got admission under SC/ST reservation categories	To be provided by Govt. of Kerala
e	Other candidates	2,50,000/-

Signed and sealed receipts shall be given by the management/ college to all fees collected. Annual tuition fees for SC/ST students shall be paid by the Government.

5. The annual fees fixed as above shall be inclusive of all amounts collected as in the case of similarly situated students in Government colleges. However, the management concerned shall be entitled to collect such other statutorily permitted fees and such other amounts collected from similarly situated students in Government Colleges and Government controlled self financing colleges which shall be specifically listed out and published each year during the entire course of study. The management concerned shall not collect any amount from any student so admitted, other than those specified above.
6. 35% of the total seats shall be treated as Management seats and shall be filled up first among the candidates who have qualified in the National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test (NEET), and who have opted for these management seats in our institution based on their inter se merit.
7. Each students thus admitted by the Management concerned to the above mentioned 35% seats shall pay annual tuition fees up to Rs.10,00,000 (Rupees Ten lakhs only) or such amount as fixed by the Fee Regulatory Committee of the Government, for which signed receipts with seal shall be given.
8. The Management concerned shall be entitled to fill up the remaining 15% seats by eligible students who are children/ dependants of Non Resident Indians applied in this institution and have qualified in the National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test (NEET). They will be selected based on their inter se merit. Such students shall be liable to pay annual tuition fees up to Rs.14,00,000 [Rupees Fourteen lakhs only]
9. The Management concerned undertakes that no consideration in cash or Kind other than those specified above shall be received, accepted or collected any form whatsoever from any student admitted to the college. It shall be the liability of the Management concerned to redress complaints from the students, parents or interested parties on any matter other than those covered by the terms and conditions of this agreement. Where the second party fails to redress any complaints referred to, as above or any matter covered under this agreement, it shall be the duty of the first party to take such steps as required under law to redress the complaint.

10. The Government shall consider providing facilities for clinical training and other assistance in Government hospital for Medical College students of Academy of Medical Sciences, based on the applications submitted by the college, on case to case basis.

11. This consensual agreement shall be submitted by the First Party, Second Party before the Admission Supervisory Committee and the Fee Regulatory Committee constituted by the State Government and shall be subject to their approval.

12. The Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram, Kannur shall be entitled to collect uniform fees approved/ endorsed for MBBS by the Fee Regulatory Committee in the State, from all students excluding those admitted under NRI quota, in the event of this consensual agreement is not got approved as stipulated in clause 11 above or consensual agreement is declared to be void or not enforceable by the Court or any authority competent to declare so.

13. Consensual agreement is declared to be void or not enforceable by the Court or any authority competent to declare so.
