FACILITY FOR ONLINE OPTION CONFIRMATION AND SUBMISSION OF FRESH
OPTIONS TO MEDICAL AND ALLIED COURSES**

The activities related to the third phase of allotment to Professional Degree Courses 2017 will begin on 16.07.2017. During this phase, allotment will be done to MBBS, BDS, Ayurveda, Agriculture, Forestry, Veterinary and Fisheries courses in addition to Engineering, Architecture and Pharmacy courses. All the candidates who want their existing higher order options in Engineering/Architecture/Pharmacy courses to be considered for this phase of allotment shall have to log into their Home Page and confirm their options by clicking the 'Confirm' button available therein. After **Online Option Confirmation**, the candidates can re-arrange their higher order options or delete the unwanted options and also register fresh options to the newly added Courses/Colleges from 16.07.2017 to 19.07.2017, 3 pm, through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. The allotment on the basis of options received upto 3 pm on 19.07.2017, will be published on 20.07.2017. The candidates who have an allotment in Engineering/Architecture/Pharmacy courses shall have to take a printout of their allotment memo and remit the fee/ balance fee payable to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations in one of the designated branches of the State Bank of India (SBI) or by way of **Online Payment** and should join the allotted course/college before 5 pm on 25.07.2017. The list of designated branches of SBI is available on the website.

The candidates who have an allotment in Medical & Allied courses should join the allotted course/college before 5 pm on 30.07.2017 after remitting the fee/ balance fee as above.

DETAILED SCHEDULE FOR THE THIRD PHASE OF ALLOTMENT

16.07.2017	Website opens for Online Option Confirmation and for enabling re-arrangement of higher options/deletion of unwanted options and registration of fresh options to the newly added Courses/Colleges.
19.07.2017 (3 pm)	Time for Online Option Confirmation and re-arrangement/ deletion/addition of options ends
20.07.2017	Publication of Allotment
22.07.2017 to 25.07.2017	Candidates who receive allotment in Engineering/Architecture/Pharmacy courses should remit the fee/balance fee payable to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations in designated branches of SBI or by way of online payment and should report before the college authorities to join the allotted college/course.
25.07.2017, 5.30 pm	All the college authorities should approve and submit the list of candidates admitted in Engineering/Architecture/Pharmacy courses through Online Admission Management System (OAMS).
22.07.2017 to 30.07.2017	Candidates who receive allotment in Medical & Allied courses should remit the fee/balance fee payable to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations in designated branches of SBI or by way of online payment and should report before the college authorities to join the allotted college/course.
30.07.2017, 5.30 pm	All the college authorities should approve and submit the list of candidates admitted in Medical & Allied courses through Online Admission Management System (OAMS).

Those who do not confirm their options online will not be considered for this phase of allotment. Also their existing higher order options in Engineering, Architecture and Pharmacy courses will be removed and will not be available in the subsequent phases. However, his/her existing allotment shall be retained if he/she has joined the college as per the second phase allotment. Online Option Confirmation is mandatory for being considered in the third phase of allotment for both candidates allotted with a course in the second phase and those who have not received any allotment in the previous phases.

The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations will be making allotments in the Third Phase to the various Professional Degree courses in the following Colleges:

Token Deposit :

Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC category and those having benefits as per G.O. (MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O. (MS) 10/2014/BCDD, dated: 23.05.2014, have to remit token deposit of Rs. 1000/- as token of having accepted the allotment:

The allotment to Colleges / Courses will be subject to recognition of All India Regulatory Bodies / Affiliation from the Universities.

Note: The candidates whose results in the respective rank lists have been withheld due to various reasons can also register their online options for allotment. But the options submitted by such candidates will not be considered for allotment unless they produce the required documents to clear the defects and release their ranks before 5 pm on 18.07.2017.

Note: The Allotment to be published on 20.07.2017 is the last phase of allotment to Private Self Financing Engineering/Architecture colleges and all the Self Financing Pharmacy colleges. Hence the students who get allotment in such colleges should invariably join the colleges allotted, before 5 pm on 25.07.2017. Otherwise they are liable to pay the Liquidated Damages as per clause 12.2.4 (c) of the Prospectus for KEAM-2017/Pharmacy Courses. Also they will not be eligible for the refund of fees, if any, paid to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

The availability of higher order options of candidates who are allotted to Private Self Financing Engineering/Architecture colleges after this allotment and levying of Liquidated Damages in the event of discontinuing the course after 25.07.2017 from such colleges shall be as per the provisions in GO(Ms)No. 166/2017/H.Edn. dated 22.06.2017, GO(Ms)No. 170/2017/H.Edn. dated 23.06.2017 and GO(Ms)No. 169/2017/H.Edn. dated 23.06.2017. However, liquidated damages may not be collected from the students admitted to Private Self Financing Engineering/Architecture colleges (except colleges under Kerala Catholic Engineering College Managements Association) who leave the course/college for getting admission in Medical & Allied courses through KEAM-2017. But the fees remitted by such students for the year shall not be refunded.

Candidates are advised to go through the various clauses relating to Liquidated Damages in the Prospectus and the relevant Government Orders available in the above website.
