ADMISSION TO MBBS/BDS COURSES UNDER MINORITY QUOTA-2017
DOCUMENTS TO PROVE MINORITY COMMUNITY INVITED FROM STUDENTS

As per GO(Rt) No. 2279/2017/H&FWD dated 16.08.2017, certain seats are earmarked in Karuna Medical College, Palakkad, Kannur Medical College, Anjarakkandi, Kannur and Kannur Dental College, Anjarakkandi, Kannur to the candidates belonging to Minority Community to which the Educational Agency belongs. These colleges had not submitted the detailed seat matrix and the details of Minority Quota to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and hence documents were not invited in respect of the Minority Quota in these colleges till date. Candidates seeking admission to these seats earmarked for Minority Quota under MBBS/BDS courses in the above Private Self Financing Medical/Dental colleges shall have to submit Minority/Community Certificates obtained from Revenue Officials to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as proof for the claim.

Candidate who wish to seek admission under Minority Quota seats in the above Private Self Financing Medical and Dental colleges having Minority Status shall have to log into the home page of the candidate through the link 'KEAM 2017-Candidate Portal' provided in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in and should click the menu item 'Minority Quota' available therein. Then a list of community categories belonging to the Minority Community along with the criteria of eligibility, documents to be furnished for claiming Minority Quota are displayed. In addition, proforma of the Community Certificate to be submitted in respect of each community category and the proforma for submitting basic details of the candidate are available for download against the community concerned. Candidates should fill up the proforma of basic details and should submit the same, along with the Minority/Community certificate obtained from Revenue Officials to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, 5th Floor, Housing Board Buildings, Santhi Nagar, Thiruvananthapuram -695 001 before 5 pm on 21.08.2017, by Registered Post/Speed Post/Hand Delivery.

Community Certificates issued by the Revenue authority alone shall be considered for claims under Minority Quota. Defective and incomplete certificates shall not be considered. Candidates should ensure before sending the documents to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations that the Community certificates are signed by the Authority concerned and proper seal is affixed in it.

Note:-

1. Candidates belonging to Muslim community who have submitted Non-Creamy Layer Certificate obtained from Revenue Officials along with application for KEAM 2017 and who have been included in the category lists for Medical courses need not submit community certificate again for inclusion under Kerala Muslim Minority Category.
2. Candidates belonging to Muslim Community who submit the community certificate prescribed for Muslim candidates from Malabar region or from Palakkad/Kannur/Kasaragod Districts shall be included under Kerala Muslim category. They need not submit separate community certificate for being included under Kerala Muslim category.
