ADMISSION TO MEDICAL & ALLIED COURSES, KERALA 2017
SUBMITTED NEET RESULT AVAILABLE FOR VERIFICATION

Candidates seeking admission to MBBS/BDS courses, other Medical courses such as Ayurveda, Homoeopathy, Siddha & Unani and Allied courses such as Agriculture, Forestry, Veterinary and Fisheries, in the State for the year 2017-18 were directed to submit their NEET (UG) 2017 result through the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations from 02.07.2017 to 08.07.2017 for preparing the respective State rank lists. A total of 51066 candidates have submitted their NEET (UG) 2017 result online within the stipulated time.

The candidates who have already taken the 'NEET Result Submission Report', the printout of which was available during the online submission of NEET result, may verify and ensure that the details such as NEET Roll Number, NEET (UG) rank, percentile score etc. shown in it are that of the candidate.

The candidates who have not taken the printout of the 'NEET Result Submission Report' from the website can download and take the printout of the 'NEET Result Submission Report' after entering the Home page through the 'KEAM-2017 Candidate Portal' provided in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in and by clicking the menu item 'NEET Result Verification' on 11.07.2017 & 12.07.2017 and can verify and ensure that the details such as NEET Roll Number, NEET (UG) rank, percentile score etc. shown in it are that of the candidate.

Discrepancies, if any, may be preferred to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations via e-mail (ceekinfo@cee.kerala.gov.in) before 5 pm on 12.07.2017. Complaints received after the stipulated time will not be considered.
