MOP-UP COUNSELLING SCHEDULED TO BE HELD ON 14.09.2018
FOR VACANCIES IN BDS SEATS THAT MAY ARISE IN CASE
THE CANDIDATES FAIL TO RE-JOIN IN TIME

After the two rounds of online allotment to Medical & Allied courses, some of the candidates admitted to BDS course were given new allotment and admission in the Mop-up counselling held on 4th and 5th of September 2018. But a few such candidates had lost their new allotment in the Mop-up counselling held on 8th and 9th of September 2018. These candidates were informed that their previous admission in BDS course will be retained and were directed to report for re-admission to the respective Dental colleges before 5 pm on 13.09.2018. Candidates who were given allotment to the 4 Private Self Financing Medical colleges newly included by virtue of the orders of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in the counselling held on 4th and 5th September 2018 and who were not allotted with any course/college in the Mop-up counselling held on 8th and 9th of September 2018 were also informed that their previous admission in BDS course, if any, will be retained and were directed to report for re-admission to the respective Dental colleges before 5 pm on 13.09.2018, if they want to retain their previous admission in BDS course. A total of 102 candidates have the facility to re-join to the previously admitted Dental Colleges before 5 pm on 13.09.2018. The admission to the BDS course is to be completed by 15th September 2018. Hence the previous admission in BDS course of the above candidates who do not report for re-admission before 5 pm on 13.09.2018 will be deemed to be cancelled and such vacant BDS seats, if any available, shall be filled up through the Mop-up Counselling to be held **at 11 am on 14.09.2018 (Friday) in the Old Auditorium inside Government Medical College Campus, Thiruvananthapuram.** All the Dental college authorities will be present in the Mop-up counselling venue for completion of admission procedure.

Conditions for Mop-up counselling

- 1) The online options already submitted by the candidates will not be considered for this Mop-up counselling. Candidates who have not submitted options online can also participate in this Mop-up counselling.
- 2) In the mop-up counselling, transfer will not be permitted to students admitted in a Government Dental College to another Government Dental College.

- 3) In the mop-up counselling, transfer will not be permitted to students admitted in a Self Financing Dental College to another Self Financing Dental College.
- 4) Transfer will be permitted in the mop-up counselling to students admitted in Self Financing Dental colleges to Government Dental colleges.
- 5) Candidates attending the Mop-up counselling should bring the Data Sheet already issued to them.

Details of Fee and mode of remittance:

Candidates getting allotment during the mop-up counselling shall have to remit the fee as given below at the venue of Mop-up counselling by way of Demand Draft drawn from a Nationalized Bank in favour of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations payable at Thiruvananthapuram.

- 1) Candidates getting allotment to BDS course in Government Dental Colleges-**Rs. 23,000/.**
- 2) Candidates getting allotment to BDS course under Government/Minority/NRI quota in Self Financing Dental Colleges- **Rs.3 lakhs.**
- 3) Candidates getting allotment to BDS course who belong to SC/ST/OEC/Children of Registered Fishermen category and those having benefits as per G.O. (MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O. (MS) 10/2014/BCDD, dated: 23.05.2014 - **Rs. 1000/-.**
- 4) Candidates, who have remitted any fee amount to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as per the allotment, if any, already received under Medical & Allied courses need submit the Demand Draft for the balance amount only.

Note: In case candidates are not available for vacant NRI quota seats from the NRI category list already published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, candidates who submit the required NRI documents in original afresh shall be considered. Also, those NEET qualified students who were not able to get registered in the KEAM rank list for Medical courses in time due to various reasons shall be allowed to attend Mop-up counselling for the vacant seats, if any, even after the main KEAM rank list got exhausted.
