MOP-UP COUNSELLING TO FILL UP THE VACANT SEATS
IN MBBS/BDS COURSES

The candidates allotted as per the second phase of allotment to Medical & Allied courses have been directed to join the respective colleges before 5 pm on 17.08.2018.

The vacant seats, if any, remaining after 17.08.2018 shall be filled up through a Mop-up counselling (Spot Admission) to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations at **Old Auditorium inside Government Medical College Campus, Thiruvananthapuram on 20th and 21st of August 2018**. The mop-up counselling will start at 9 am on 20.08.2018 and will continue on 21.08.2018 in case the counselling is not completed on 20.08.2018. The Mop-up counselling will be for filling up the vacant seats in MBBS/BDS courses only. Candidates who get allotment to MBBS/BDS courses in Mop-up counselling shall have to join the allotted colleges then and there itself, after remitting the required fee. During Mop-up counselling, all the Medical/Dental college authorities in the State shall be present at the venue of the Mop-up counselling for completing the admission procedure.

Guidelines for Mop-up counselling

- (i) During the mop-up counselling, transfer will not be permitted to students admitted in a Government Medical College to another Government Medical College or for students admitted in a Self Financing Medical College to another Self Financing Medical College.
- (ii) During the mop-up counselling, transfer will not be permitted to students admitted in a Government Dental College to another Government Dental College or for students admitted in a Self Financing Dental College to another Self Financing Dental College.
- (iii) Transfer will be permitted during the mop-up counselling to students admitted in Self Financing Medical/Dental colleges to Government Medical/Dental colleges and vice-versa.
- (iv) Transfer from NRI seat to Government/Minority seat shall be permitted between two Self Financing colleges or in the same college, even if it is for the same course.

Details of Fee and mode of remittance:

Candidates getting allotment during the mop-up counselling shall have to remit the fee as given below at the venue of Mop-up counselling by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations payable at Thiruvananthapuram.

- 1) Candidates getting allotment to MBBS course in Government Medical Colleges- **Rs. 25,000/-**.
- 2) Candidates getting allotment to BDS course in Government Dental Colleges- **Rs. 23,000/-**.
- 3) Candidates getting allotment to MBBS course under Government/Minority/NRI quota in Self Financing Medical Colleges- **Rs.5 lakhs**.
- 4) Candidates getting allotment to BDS course under Government/Minority/NRI quota in Self Financing Dental Colleges- **Rs.3 lakhs**.
- 5) Candidates getting allotment to MBBS/BDS courses who belong to SC/ST/OEC/Children of Registered Fishermen category and those having benefits as per G.O. (MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O. (MS) 10/2014/BCDD, dated: 23.05.2014 - **Rs. 1000/-**.
- 6) Candidates who have already remitted any fee amount to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as per the allotment, if any, received under Medical & Allied courses need submit the Demand Draft for the balance amount only.

Online registration for Mop-up counselling:

Candidates who wish to participate in the Mop-up counselling to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations at Thiruvananthapuram shall have to register online through the website of Commissioner for Entrance Examinations www.cee.kerala.gov.in from 16.08.2018 to 18.08.2018, 5 pm. Such candidates will be issued with a 'Mop-up counselling Slip' which can be downloaded from the webpage. This 'Mop-up counselling Slip' should be produced at the venue of mop-up counselling.

Documents to be submitted at the time of Mop-up Counselling:

Candidates who wish to participate in the mop-up counselling shall have to register online through the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and then appear for the mop-up counselling with the following documents.

- 1) Mop-up counselling Slip
- 2) Demand Draft for the requisite amount
- 3) Candidates who are not admitted to any of the courses at present shall have to produce the original Transfer Certificate from the Institution last attended, Conduct Certificate and Original mark list(s) of the qualifying examination (Higher Secondary or equivalent) along with the Pass certificate of the qualifying examination (if issued).
- 4) Candidates allotted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and admitted to courses other than MBBS/BDS shall have to produce a 'Possession Certificate' obtained from the Head of the institution stating that the original documents of the candidate including Transfer Certificate is under the safe custody of the institution and self- attested copies of all the certificates showing his/her educational qualifications.
- 5) Candidates who are not allotted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations but presently admitted to any of the courses shall have to produce 'No Objection Certificate' obtained from the Head of the institution stating that the institution has no objection in relieving the candidate, 'Possession Certificate' obtained from the Head of the institution presently admitted and self- attested copies of all the certificates showing his/her educational qualifications.
- 6) Eligibility certificate from any University in Kerala, in the case of candidates who have passed a qualifying examination other than Higher Secondary Examination/Vocational Higher Secondary Examination conducted by Government of Kerala or the examination conducted by CBSE and CISCE.
- 7) Migration Certificate, if applicable.
- 8) Certificate to prove date of birth.
- 9) Data sheet of KEAM 2018.
- 10) Physical Fitness Certificate in the relevant format given in Annexure XVII (b) of the Prospectus 2018.
- 11) Candidates who seek admission under NRI quota shall have to produce the original documents to prove NRI claim (see the office notifications dated 22.11.2017 and 14.06.2018 available in the website).

Important:

Keeping in view of the Holidays and other eventualities, candidates are directed to secure the Demand Drafts, Possession Certificate and No Objection Certificate (if applicable) at the earliest, so as to be submitted at the time of mop-up counselling. The students who are not in possession of the requisite fee as Demand Draft and the required documents (as applicable) shall not be given admission to the courses.
