**ONLINE ALLOTMENT FOR SECOND PHASE TO MEDICAL & ALLIED COURSES AND
TO FILL UP THE VACANT SEATS IN ENGINEERING/ARCHITECTURE/PHARMACY COURSES**
ONLINE OPTION CONFIRMATION IS MANDATORY

The activities related to the second phase of allotment to Medical & Allied courses commenced on 23.07.2018. In this phase, the vacant seats in Engineering/Architecture courses in Govt./Aided Engineering colleges as well as Government Controlled Self Financing Engineering colleges and the vacant seats in B.Pharm course in Govt./Self Financing Pharmacy colleges also shall be filled in addition to the allotment to Medical & Allied courses. Candidates included in the Rank Lists for Engineering/Architecture/Pharmacy Courses 2018 and who want to be considered for this phase of allotment shall have to perform **Online Option Confirmation**. After Online Option Confirmation, candidates can register fresh options to the newly included colleges under Medical & Allied courses and also can re-arrange their existing higher options / delete the unwanted higher options. The Facility for Online Option Confirmation and registration of fresh options/re-arranging the existing higher options/deleting the unwanted higher options will be available in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in up to 12 noon on 26.07.2018 (Thursday).

The higher order options of candidates who have not joined the college allotted in the first phase of allotment to Medical & Allied courses and those who have discontinued the course after joining have been cancelled. Similarly, the higher order options in the stream concerned, of candidates who do not join the college allotted in the third phase of allotment to Engineering/Architecture/Pharmacy courses within the stipulated time and those who discontinue the course after joining shall be cancelled even if they have performed Online Option Confirmation.

The higher order options in Engineering courses of those candidates who are allotted and admitted in the Private Self Financing Engineering Colleges in the third phase of allotment shall be deleted in accordance with the provisions in the related Government Orders. Similarly, the higher order options in Architecture of those candidates who are allotted and admitted to Private Self Financing Architecture Colleges in the third phase of allotment shall be deleted in accordance with the provisions in the related Government Order. These candidates will not be considered for Engineering/Architecture courses in this vacancy filling allotment.

Candidates who want to be considered for the second phase of allotment to Medical & Allied courses and who want their existing higher order options under Engineering/Architecture/Pharmacy courses to be considered for this phase of online allotment shall have to log into their Home Page and confirm their options by clicking the 'Confirm' button available therein. After **Online Option Confirmation**, the candidates can register fresh options to the newly included colleges under Medical & Allied courses and can re-arrange / delete their higher order options up to **12 noon on 26.07.2018** through the above website. The allotment on the basis of options existing up to **12 noon on 26.07.2018** will be published in the evening on **26.07.2018**. The candidates who receive allotment shall have to take a printout of their allotment memo and remit the fee/ balance fee (if applicable) payable to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations in any of the Head Post Offices in Kerala or by way of online payment and should join the course/college allotted. The list of Post Offices having facility for fee payment is available in the website. The candidates who get allotment to Private Self Financing Pharmacy colleges shall have to invariably join the college allotted before 5 pm on 30.07.2018. The last date for joining the other courses will be notified later.

Online Option Confirmation is mandatory for being considered in this phase of allotment to the existing higher options in Engineering/Architecture/Pharmacy/Medical/Allied courses for both candidates allotted with a course in the previous phase and those who have not received any allotment in the previous phase. Those who do not confirm their options online will not be considered for the online allotment for second phase to Medical & Allied courses and to fill up the vacant seats in Engineering, Architecture and Pharmacy courses. However his/her existing allotment shall be retained if he/she has joined the course/college as per the previous allotment.

Candidates can register fresh options to the following colleges in this phase.

Token Deposit :

Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC category and those having benefits as per G.O. (MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O. (MS) 10/2014/BCDD, dated: 23.05.2014, have to remit token deposit of **Rs. 1000/-** to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as token of having accepted the allotment and should join the college allotted within the stipulated time.

The candidates getting allotment are liable to remit the fee fixed by the Fee Regulatory Committee if the fee fixed on the basis of agreement between Government and Self-financing Managements is not approved by the Hon'ble Court or any competent authority.

The allotment to Colleges / Courses will be subject to recognition of All India Regulatory Bodies, Affiliation from the Universities and Government Orders.

Candidates are advised to file options to the courses/colleges to which they are sure to join and continue studies if allotted, at the time of registration of options.
