

NOTIFICATION ALLOTMENT / ADMISSION TO DNB (POST MBBS) STATE QUOTA -2020

- 1. Applications are invited from the candidates who have qualified in NEET-PG 2020, conducted by National Board of Examinations, for admission to **DNB** -**Post MBBS State Quota** seats at various District/General Hospitals under the Health Services Department for the academic year 2020-21. The list of institutions in which State quota seats available this year are:
 - General Hospital, Thiruvananthapuram
 - General Hospital Ernakulum District
 - District Hospital, Palakkad.
 If any new seat is added to the State Quota latest stage before the closing of allotments, such seats will also be included in the remaining phases, if any, of the allotment process.
 If the new seat(s) happened to be in an institution not in the above list, such institution(s) will become part of the allotment process from that stage onward.

2. Eligibility for Admission:

a. Applicants in possession of MBBS degree or provisional MBBS pass certificate recognized by MCI with MBBS qualification registered permanently or provisionally with MCI 1956 and possessing permanent or provisional registration certificate of MBBS qualification issued by the MCs or State Medical Council completed one year of internship on or before 31st March 2020 are eligible to apply. For admission to State quota seats of DNB Post MBBS candidates should obtain registration of T C Medical Council.

Candidates already pursuing a DNB course are not eligible for admission in DNB Course till such time they have completed the entire duration of the prescribed course or have been discharged from the course. Candidates who have joined DNB Broad Specialty course in or after January 2018 admission session are not eligible for admission to January 2020 session. This shall be irrespective of their resignation or discontinuation from the course due to any reason.

It may also be noted that once a candidate joins a Post Graduate Medical Degree/Diploma seat allotted to him/her in the 50% All India Quota (AIQ) or Deemed/Central universities/AFMS through the NEET (PG) -2020 All India Counseling conducted by the Medical Counseling committee (MCC), Government of India or in any State Quota through the NEET (PG)-2020 State level counseling conducted by the concerned State Government, and does not quit the seat before the deadline set for legitimate exit from such seats as per the relevant guidelines issued by the MCI and/or the MCC or the state concerned, as the case may be, he/she shall not be eligible to participate in any rounds of counseling for the DNB (Post MBBS) 2020 allotment process.

- b. Nativity: Indian citizen of Kerala origin.
- c. Age: There is no Upper age limit for admission.
- d. Qualifying criteria:- All candidates seeking admission to DNB (Post MBBS) courses in the State of Kerala for the academic year 2020-21 shall have qualified the National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test for Post-Graduate Medical Courses (NEET PG-2020) conducted by the National Board of Examination, New Delhi. The qualifying cut off percentile required for the candidates to be eligible for admission courses are as follows (Vide letter No.B.110112/15/2020/MEP, dated 14.07.2020 MoHFW).

e. Eligibility criteria for Foreign Medical Graduates:

Keralites who have obtained their primary medical qualification from Medical colleges outside India should have qualified the Foreign Medical Graduate Examination (Screening Test) conducted by NBE. This is in addition to all the other eligibility criteria stated above.

3. <u>Submission of Applications and Application Fee</u>: All candidates seeking admission to the DNB Post (MBBS) Course 2020 can apply in the Online application form available from 10.08.2020 provided in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and then remit the required fee by way of online payment or by way of e-challan available during the submission of online application. Payment through e-challan can be made in cash at any of the Head/Sub Post offices in Kerala. After remitting the required application fee the candidate should upload signature and all necessary certificates as proof of eligibility and various claims. www.cee.kerala.gov.in of the Commissioner for Entrance to send printout of the application or any documents to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

<u>Application Fee:</u> Candidates are required to pay the Application Fee of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One thousand only) (excluding payment gateway charges). But, in the case of SC/ST candidates and those eligible for SC/ST benefits as per G.O.(MS) No.25/2005/SC/STDD dated 20.06.2005, application fee to be paid is Rs. 500/-(Rupees Five hundred Only) (excluding payment gateway charges). Application fee shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

- 4. <u>Last date and Time for the submission of online application</u>: All candidates seeking admission to the course should submit the online application along with uploaded documents/certificates mentioned in clause 10 of the Information Bulletin to DNB Post MBBS before 5.00 PM of 14.08.2020. Defective and incomplete applications will be summarily rejected. No correspondence will be undertaken in this regard. Candidates will be allowed, neither to include any information in the application form nor to submit any certificates/documents claiming reservation or any benefits, after the submission of the online application.
- 5. The candidates claiming reservation under Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/SEBC/Special quota should upload necessary certificates and documents in proof of their claim from the concerned authorities in the prescribed format together with the Online Applications.
- 6. <u>Mode of selection:</u> The selection of the candidates to the course shall be made from the rank list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Kerala on the basis of NEET PG 2020 rank list subject to satisfying the eligibility conditions as in Clause 2 of the Information Bulletin.
- 7. The admissions to the State Quota seats in DNB Post MBBS in various General/District Hospitals in Kerala under the Health Services Department for the Year 2020-21 shall be done through a Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations from State Rank lists which will be prepared on the basis of NEET-PG 2020 rank list.

- 8. <u>Data Sheet</u>: Candidates eligible for allotment/admission to the courses will be issued Data Sheet which can be downloaded from the website <u>www.cee.kerala.gov.in</u> from the date which will be notified later.
