NOTIFICATION
ALLOTMENT / ADMISSION TO DNB
(POST DIPLOMA) STATE QUOTA -2020

1. Applications are invited for admission to the State Quota seat in DNB Post Diploma Courses for the academic year 2020-21. Applicants qualified in the DNB PDCET-2020 conducted by National Board of Examinations are eligible to apply. One seat in Anaesthesiology is available for the course at General Hospital, Thiruvananthapuram under the Health Service Department for the academic year 2020-21. If any new seat is added to the State quota at a later stage before the closing of allotment such seats will also be included in the remaining phases, if any of the allotment process. If the new seat(s) happened to be in an institution not in the above list, such institution(s) will become part of the allotment process from that stage onward.
 2. **Eligibility for Admission:**
 - a. Applicants must have passed the final examination of Post Graduate diploma in Anaesthesia (D.A (Anaesthesia) from Indian Universities which are the recognized as per provision of Indian Medical council Act 1956, Govt. of India, ie have passed final examination for post graduate diploma on or before 30th November 2019.
 - b. **Candidates must have qualified in DNB- PD CET-2020.**
 - c. **Nativity:** Applicants must have Indian citizen of Kerala origin.
 - d. **Age:** There is no Upper age limit for admission to DNB Post Diploma Course 2020-21.

 3. **Mode of selection:-**

The selection of the candidates shall be made from the rank list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Kerala on the basis of DNB PDCET 2020 scores subject to satisfying the eligibility conditions as in clause 2 of the Information Bulletin.
 4. **Submission of Applications and Application Fee:** All candidates seeking admission to the DNB Post Diploma Courses 2020 can apply in the Online application form available from 10.08.2020 provided in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and then remit the required fee by way of online payment or by way of e-challan available during the submission of online application. Payment through e-challan can be made in cash at any of the Head/Sub Post offices in Kerala. After remitting the required application fee the candidate should upload signature and all necessary certificates as proof of eligibility and various claims. **No need to send printout of the application or any documents to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.**
- Application Fee:** Candidates are required to pay the Application Fee of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One thousand only) (excluding payment gateway charges). But, in the case of SC/ST candidates and those eligible for SC/ST benefit as per G.O.(MS)No.25/2005/SC/STDD dated 20.06.2005, the application fee to be paid is Rs.500/-(Rupees Five hundred only) (excluding payment gateway charges). Application fee shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
5. **Last date and Time for the submission of online application:** All candidates seeking admission to the course should submit the online application along with uploaded documents/certificates mentioned in clause 8 of the Information Bulletin to DNB Post Diploma Courses before 5.00 pm of 14.08.2020. Defective and incomplete applications will be summarily rejected. No correspondence will be undertaken in this regard.

6. The candidates claiming reservation under Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/SEBC/Special quota should upload necessary certificates and documents in proof of their claim from the concerned authorities in the prescribed format together with the Online Applications.
7. The admissions to the State Quota seats in DNB Post Diploma Courses 2020 in General Hospital, Thiruvananthapuram for the Year 2020-21 shall be done through a common counseling to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations from State Rank lists which will be prepared on the basis of DNB PDCET 2020 scores.
8. Candidates will be allowed, neither to include any information in the application form nor to submit any certificates/documents claiming reservation or any benefits, after the submission of the online application.
9. **Data Sheet:** Candidates eligible for allotment/admission to the courses will be issued Data Sheet which can be downloaded from the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from the date which will be notified later.
10. The selection and allotment of seats to the course will be made by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations through the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP). It will be notified later. Details of the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) will be published in the official web site www.cee.kerala.gov.in of the commissioner for Entrance Examinations in due course.
