### ADMISSION TO THREE YEAR LLB COURSE IN GOVERNMENT LAW COLLEGES AND PRIVATE SELF FINANCING LAW COLLEGES OF KERALA FOR THE YEAR 2014-15 FINAL PHASE OF ALLOTMENT

The final phase of centralised allotment for admission to three year LLB Course in four Government Law Colleges and six Private Self-financing Law Colleges of the State for the year 2014-15 will be published on **24.10.2014 (Friday)**.

Candidates can re-arrange their options/delete their unwanted higher options through the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) from **21.10.2014 to 23.10.2014, 5 pm**.

Candidates who are satisfied with the admission they got in the 1<sup>st</sup> phase of allotment should delete all their higher order options.

The detailed schedule for the allotment is given below:

**Fees:** The first year tuition fees in Govt. Law Colleges is Rs.1500/-. In Private Self Financing Law Colleges the first year tuition fees is Rs.20000/-, with a refundable deposit of Rs.50000/-.

The detailed fee structure for three Year LLB Course 2014 in Government Law Colleges and private self financing law colleges fixed by Government vide G.O (Ms) No.577/2013/H.Edn dated 17.08.2013 and G.O (Ms)No. 630/2013/H.Edn dated 28.09.2013 respectively are available on the website, [www.cee-kerala.org](http://www.cee-kerala.org) . The annual tuition fee and other fees including deposits, if any, for Three Year LLB Course 2014 should be remitted in the allotted colleges at the time of admission.

Candidates who receive allotment should have attained the eligibility for admission as per Clause 6 of the Prospectus at the time of admission.

**Documents to be produced at the time of admission.**

1. Admit Card of the Entrance Examination.
2. Allotment letter issued by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
3. SSLC or any relevant record to prove date of birth
4. Original Mark list and Pass Certificate of the qualifying examination.
5. Transfer Certificate and conduct certificate from the institution where the candidate studied last.
6. Two copies of recent passport size photograph
7. The applicant who is employed or trainee in Government/quasi government/Banks etc. shall produce a relieving order and a certificate of good conduct from the Head of the institution where the candidate was employed.
8. Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from Universities/Boards outside the State shall produce an "Eligibility Certificate" from a University in Kerala, to the effect that the qualifying examination has been recognised by the University.
9. The student who qualifies from other Universities should produce migration certificate at the time of admission.

**Candidates who do not take admission on the specified dates will lose their allotment.**

Candidates who receive allotment to their higher options in the final phase of allotment, should get the T.C, relevant documents and amount remitted at the time of admission from their present colleges and join the newly allotted colleges on the above specified dates, failing which they will lose their current admission also.
