ALLOTMENT TO THREE YEAR LL.B COURSE 2016-17 ONLINE OPTIONS INVITED

The Centralised Allotment Process for admission to Three Year LL.B Course in four Government Law Colleges and 7 Private Self-financing Law Colleges of the State for the year 2016-17 commences on **02.11.2016 (Wednesday)**.

Candidates included in the rank list can register their options online through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from **02.11.2016 to 07.11.2016, 5 pm**. [See Clause 15 of the Prospectus]. Candidate may enter their Application Number & Roll Number in the link 'Three Year LL.B 2016 - Candidate Portal' provided in the above website to log on to their home page. They can download key number by clicking the menu item 'Print Key Number' by providing their password. Then by clicking the menu item 'Option Registration' and by submitting their key number and password, candidate can register their options online. The first allotment based on the online options received upto 5 pm on 07.11.2016 will be published on **08.11.2016**. Candidates who get allotment shall have to join the allotted colleges on any date from 09.11.2016 to 11.11.2016.

Candidates who fail to register their options online will not be considered for allotment under any circumstances. Options submitted to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by Fax/Post/Hand delivery will not be processed or considered on any account for the allotment of seats.

The annual tuition fee, other fees and the deposits (if applicable) should be remitted in the allotted colleges at the time of admission. The relevant Govt. Order detailing the annual tuition fee, other fees and the deposits is available in the website for reference.

Candidates who receive allotment should have attained the eligibility for admission as per Clause 6 of the Prospectus at the time of admission.

Documents to be produced at the time of admission

- 1) Admit card of the Entrance Examination.
- 2) Allotment Memo issued by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- 3) SSLC or any relevant school records/ birth certificate/ other valid document to prove date of birth.
- 4) Original Mark list and Degree Certificate of the qualifying examination.
- 5) Transfer certificate and conduct certificate from the institution where the candidate studied last.
- 6) Two copies of recent passport size photograph.
- 7) The applicant who is employed or trainee in Government/Quasi Government/ Bank etc. shall, at the time of interview, produce a relieving order and a certificate of good conduct from the Head of the institution where the candidate was employed
- 8) Candidate who passed their qualifying examination from Universities/Boards outside the state shall produce an "Eligibility Certificate" from a university in Kerala, to the effect that the qualifying examination has been recognised by the University.
- 9) The student who qualifies from other Universities should produce migration certificate at the time of admission.

Candidates who do not take admission within the specified dates shall lose their allotment as well as their further claims in the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP).

Candidates are advised not to give unnecessary options to courses/colleges where they do not wish to join, if allotted. All details related to the allotment process are available on the website www.cee-kerala.org.
