ORDER

Government have approved the prospectus for admission to Integrated 5 year LL.B Course for the year 2011-12 vide G.O read as 1st paper above. As per the conditions stipulated in “Clause 12 (V)” of the approved prospectus, it is stated that:

“ (V) Qualifying Standards in Entrance Examination – To qualify thereby figure in the rank list for admission to Integrated Five Year LL.B Course, a General category candidate should get a minimum of 25% of total marks in the Entrance Examination and a candidate belonging to SC/ST category should get a minimum of 20% of total marks where the total marks being 600 in the Entrance Examination.”

The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations vide letter read as 2nd paper above has proposed to remove/reduce the higher range of minimum qualifying standards for the Entrance Examination.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to amend the Clause 12 (V) of the approved prospectus as detailed below:-

“To qualify and thereby figure in the rank list for admission to Integrated Five Year LL.B Course, a General category candidate should get a minimum of 20% of the total marks in the Entrance Examination and a candidate belonging to SC/ST category should get a minimum of 15% of total marks where the total marks being 600 in the Entrance Examination”


