### **ALLOTMENT TO INTEGRATED FIVE YEAR LLB COURSE 2018-19** **SECOND PHASE OF ALLOTMENT**

#### **AVAILABILITY OF WEBSITE FOR ONLINE OPTION CONFIRMATION AND RE-ARRANGEMENT**

The activities related to the Second and Final phase of Centralised Allotment for admission to Integrated Five Year LL.B Course in the four Government Law Colleges and 19 Private Self-financing Law Colleges in the State for the year 2018-19 will commence on **17.09.2018 (Monday)**.

Candidates who are having valid options and who are willing to participate in this phase of allotment **must compulsorily confirm their online options**, by clicking the 'Confirm' button available in their home page. After Online Option Confirmation, the candidates can delete the unwanted higher options and can re-arrange the existing higher options. The facility for option confirmation/deletion/re-arrangement will be available in the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) from **17.09.2018 to 20.09.2018, 5 pm**. **Those who do not confirm their higher options online within the stipulated time will not be considered for this phase of allotment.** The requests for option confirmation/re-arrangement/deletion of options received via Post/Fax/e-mail will not be considered.

**Note:-**

- NSS Law College (Kollam) and The Kerala Law Academy Law College (Thiruvananthapuram) are included in the second phase of allotment for admission to Integrated Five Year LL.B course - 2018 as they have received the accreditation from the Bar Council of India, NOC from Government of Kerala and the affiliation order from the University concerned.
- Bharata Matha School of Legal Studies (Aluva) is included in the second phase of allotment in compliance with the order of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in WP (C) No. 30131/2018 dated 14.09.2018.
- Bhavan's N.A Palkhivala Accademy of Advanced Legal Studies and Research (Kozhikode) is provisionally included in the second phase of allotment in compliance with the order of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in WP (C) No. 30341/2018(P) dated 14.09.2018. Allotment to this college will be subject to final order of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in this writ petition.
- Al Ameen Law College (Shornur) is included in the second phase of allotment subject to the availability of the accreditation from the Bar Council of India and NOC from the Government of Kerala.

Even though options were invited to the above mentioned Self Financing Law Colleges, these colleges were not included in the first phase allotment. Hence candidates who have not registered options to these colleges in the first phase of allotment can now give options to these colleges/courses.

Government Law Colleges	Annual Tuition Fee - Rs.1500/-
Private Self Financing Law College (Govt. Seats)	Annual Tuition Fee - Rs.15,000/- + Refundable Deposit - Rs. 50,000/-

The annual tuition fee, other fees and the deposits (if applicable) should be remitted in the allotted colleges at the time of admission. The relevant Government Order detailing the annual tuition fee, other fees and the deposits is available in the website for reference.

Candidates who receive allotment should have attained the eligibility for admission as per Clause 6 of the Prospectus at the time of admission.

**Candidates who do not take admission on the specified dates will lose their existing allotment.**

Candidates who receive allotment to their higher options in the second phase of allotment, should get the Transfer Certificate, relevant documents and amount remitted at the time of admission from their present colleges and join the newly allotted colleges on the above specified dates, failing which they will lose their current admission also.
