



**NOTIFICATION**

**ENTRANCE EXAMINATION FOR ADMISSION TO  
INTEGRATED FIVE YEAR LL.B COURSE, KERALA - 2019-20  
APPLICATIONS INVITED**

1. Applications are invited for the Entrance Examination for Admission to **Integrated Five Year LL.B Course 2019-20** in the four Government Law Colleges in Kerala and in the Private Self-financing Law Colleges which enter into seat sharing agreement with the State Government.
2. **Eligibility for Admission:**
  - (i) **Nativity:** Applicant should be an **Indian Citizen**. However, only those candidates who are of Kerala origin are eligible for any type of reservation or any fee concession. [See clause 6(i) of the Prospectus]
  - (ii) **Academic Qualifications:**
    - (a) Candidate should have passed the Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala or any other examination recognised by the Universities in Kerala as equivalent thereto.
    - (b) A candidate who has passed an examination in 10+2 Course of schooling recognised by the educational authority of the Central or State Government or possesses such academic qualifications which are considered equivalent to such 10+2 course by the Bar Council of India can also apply for admission to the course. Applicants who have obtained +2 Higher Secondary pass certificate or first degree certificate after prosecuting studies in distance or correspondence method shall also be considered as eligible for admission. The applicants who have obtained 10+2 or graduation/post graduation through open universities system directly without having any basic qualification for prosecuting such studies are not eligible for admission.
    - (c) Candidates who are appearing/ appeared for the qualifying examination are also eligible to apply for the Entrance Examination. Such candidates become eligible for admission only if they produce the Pass Certificate and Mark List of the qualifying examination at the time of admission.
    - (d) No candidate shall be admitted to the Course, unless he/she has passed the qualifying examination with a minimum of 45% marks. However, candidates belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward Classes need only 42% marks and those belonging to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes need only 40% marks in the qualifying examination. No rounding off of percentage of marks to the nearest higher integer is permitted.
  - (iii) **Age:** The applicant should have completed 17 years of age as on **31.12.2019**. The upper age limit for admission to the Integrated Five Year LL-B Course-2019 will be subject to the final orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the related petitions.
  - (iv) **Qualifying Standards in the Entrance Examination:** To qualify and thereby figure in the rank list for admission to the Integrated Five Year LL.B Course, a General category candidate should get a minimum of 10% of total marks in the Entrance Examination and a candidate belonging to SC/ST category should get a minimum of 5% of total marks, the total marks being 600 in the Entrance Examination.
3. **Entrance Examination:** The Entrance Examination will be conducted at Thiruvananthapuram, Kottayam, Ernakulam, Thrissur, Kozhikode and Kannur districts on **22.05.2019 (Wednesday)**. The Entrance Examination shall be a **Computer Based Test (CBT)** of two hours duration and will consist of 200 objective type questions in (a) General English (60 questions), (b) General Knowledge (45 questions), (c) Arithmetic and Mental Ability (25 questions) and (d) Aptitude for Legal Studies (70 questions) of three marks each [Total: 200 x 3 = 600 marks]. For every wrong answer one mark will be deducted from the total score.
4. **Submission of Online Application and Application Fee:** The application fee is **Rs. 650/-** (Rupees six hundred and fifty only) for General/SEBC candidates and **Rs. 325/-** (Rupees three hundred and twenty

five only) for SC/ST candidates. Candidates seeking admission to the course can apply online through the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and then remit the required application fee by way of Online Payment or through selected Head/Sub Post Offices in Kerala by way of e-challan available during the submission of online application [see clause 13.2.3]. Application fee once remitted will not be refunded. After remitting the fee the candidate has to upload a recent passport size colour photograph, signature and required documents/certificates as mentioned in clause 13.2.4 of the Prospectus during the submission of the online application. Facility for submission of Online application, fee payment and uploading of images/documents shall be available in the above website from **29.04.2019 to 08.05.2019, 5pm**. No need to send the printout of the Confirmation Page and supporting documents to the office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

**Certificates/Documents to be uploaded in the Online Application**

- Nativity Proof: Any one of the documents mentioned under clause 6(i).
  - Certificate to prove age: Relevant page of SSLC/Birth Certificate/Passport of the candidate.
  - Caste Certificate obtained from Tahsildar in the case of SC/ST candidates.
  - Non-Creamy Layer Certificate from the Village Officer concerned in the case of SEBC/OEC candidates.[Non-Creamy Layer Certificate issued for 'State Education purpose' only will be accepted]
  - Community Certificate from the Village Officer concerned in the case of OEC candidates who do not come under Non-Creamy layer category.
  - Income Certificate and Non-Creamy Layer Certificate (issued for 'State Education purpose' only)/Community certificate from the Village officer concerned in the case of candidates belonging to the communities listed in Annexure IV (a) for availing educational concessions as applicable to OEC category.
  - Inter-Caste marriage certificate: Candidates who are children of Inter-Caste married couple of whom one is SC/ST, need to upload Inter-Caste marriage Certificate issued by Tahsildar.
  - Attested copy of Certificate from the District Medical Board for Persons with Disabilities (if applicable) certifying the degree or percentage of disability issued not earlier than 12 months prior to the submission of application.
  - Certificate in support of Special Reservation, if any, in the prescribed format.
  - Certificate from the Fisheries Officer concerned of Kerala Fishermen Welfare Fund Board for fee concession in the case of candidates who are children of registered Fishermen.
  - Certificate from the Director, Department of Women & Child Development for fee concession in case of candidates who are inmates of Sri Chithra Home, Nirbhaya Home, Juvenile Home or any other such institution run by the Government
5. Candidates will be allowed neither to include any additional information in the application nor to submit any certificate / document claiming reservation or any benefits, after the submission of the online application.
6. Certificates obtained in the prescribed format available along with the online application and uploaded alone will be accepted as proof for claim of Special Reservation.
7. **Admit Card:** The candidates registered for the Entrance Examination can download their Admit Cards from the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) from the date which will be notified later. The admit card thus obtained should be brought to the examination hall for verification.
8. **Allotment of Seats:** Allotment of seats will be made by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations in accordance with the ranks obtained by the candidates in the Entrance Examination and the order of preference of institutions (options) registered by the candidates during online Centralised Allotment Process (CAP). The details of CAP will be notified in the website and in leading newspapers. Individual intimation in this regard will not be sent to the candidates.
9. The Entrance Examination and subsequent allotments will be based on the provisions laid down in the Prospectus for Admission to Integrated 5 Year LL.B Course 2019-20 available in the website [www.cee-kerala.org](http://www.cee-kerala.org). Candidates are advised to read the Prospectus carefully before submitting their online applications.
