ADMISSION TO MCA COURSE 2012-13

FIRST PHASE OF ALLOTMENT

The First Phase of Centralised Allotment for admission to MCA Course 2012-13 in Government, Aided, Government Controlled/Private Self Financing Colleges of the State will be published on 20.11.2012 (Tuesday) on the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in.

Candidates can access their homepage by entering their application number, roll number and key number to download their allotment memo. The details such as candidate's name, roll number, allotment details, reservations allowed, tuition fees/amount payable in bank etc are available in the allotment memo. The candidate should take a print out of the allotment memo.

Candidates who receive allotment should approach one of the designated branches of the State Bank of Travancore (SBT) along with the allotment memo and remit the prescribed tuition fees/amount on 21st and 22nd of November 2012 and get the fee receipt. The list of designated branches of State Bank of Travancore (SBT) is available on the website www.cee-kerala.org. Candidates who do not remit the fees/amount in the bank on the specified dates will not get admission and also will lose their allotment and higher options.

Candidates receiving allotment should report for admission to the Principal of the allotted colleges on the 23rd and 26th of November 2012, along with the allotment memo, fee receipt and originals of documents specified in Clause 13 of the Prospectus. The candidates who do not take admission in colleges on the specified dates, will lose their current allotment and higher options and will not be considered for further allotments.

Principals of Colleges shall furnish the non-joining report online and its signed printout by fax to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations before 5 p.m. on 27.11.2012
