ORDER

In partial modification of the G.O read as second paper above, Government are pleased to amend the prospectus for admission to MCA courses 2012-13, as below:

(I)The clause 6(B)-Mandatory Reservation, of the prospectus shall be replaced as

"

6. (B) Mandatory Reservation

Leaving the seats set apart under items (A) above, the remaining seats will be distributed as per the mandatory reservation principle as follows:

a) For Government and Government Aided Institutions:

(i) State Merit (SM) - 54%

(ii) Forward Community Members belonging to BPL category - 10%

(As per G.O(Rt)No.11/2012.H.Edn.dated. 03.01.2012)

(iii) Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC) - 26%

a) Ezhava (EZ) - 9%

b) Muslim (MU) - 8%

c) Other Backward Hindu (BH) - 5%

d) Latin Catholic (LC) - 2%

e) Other Backward Christian (BX) - 1%

f) Kudumbi (KU) - 1%

(iv) **Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes - 10%**

a) Scheduled Caste (SC) - 8%

b) Scheduled Tribe (ST) - 2%

b) For All Self Financing Institutions:

(i) **State Merit (SM) - 64%**

(ii) **Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC) - 26%**

a) Ezhava (EZ) -9%

b) Muslim (MU) -8%

c) Other Backward Hindu (BH) -5%

d) Latin Catholic (LC) -2%

e) Other Backward Christian (BX) -1%

f) Kudumbi (KU) -1%

(iii) **Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes - 10%**

a) Scheduled Caste (SC) -8%

b) Scheduled Tribe (ST) -2%

Note: i. The seats unavailed by the SC candidates will go to the ST candidates and vice versa for all colleges.

ii. The seats unavailed by the SC/ST candidates will be filled from OEC category for all colleges.

iii. The seats unavailed in any reservation quota will go to General Merit for all colleges.

iv. The seats unavailed by SEBC candidates will be allotted to State Merit candidates in the final allotment for all colleges.

v. As per G.O.(Rt)No.11/2012.H.Edn.dated. 03.01.2012, 10% of seats in MCA Course run by Government / Government aided institutions is reserved for candidates belonging to forward community, who are classified as members of BPL family. The seats reserved in Government / Government aided institutions for Forward Community Members belonging to BPL category will be allocated college wise, and the seats unavailed by them will be allotted to State Merit candidates.

(II) Clause 5.(b). 3 of the prospectus shall be replaced as

Colleges affiliated to the UNIVERSITY of CALICUT

A Pass in any Bachelor's Degree Course of minimum three years duration with Mathematics or Statistics as one of the subjects. In addition to Mathematics or Statistics subjects, following subjects shall also be considered as eligible subject in this aspect.

Discrete Structures, Numerical Analysis, Numerical Methods, Optimization Techniques, Digital Logic Design, Graph Theory, Operations Research, Fuzzy Mathematics, Linear Algebra, Complex Analysis, Design Algorithms, Functional Analysis, Probability, Numerical Skills/Techniques, Data Structures, Differential Equations.

Candidate should have passed a Bachelor's Degree Course which is recognized by University of Calicut.

Candidate should have scored at least 50% marks in aggregate (including subjects and languages) in the bachelor's Degree Course. 5% of relaxation in the marks will be allowed in the case of candidates belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward Classes. Candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe need only a pass in the Bachelor's Degree Course.

The G.O read as second paper above stands modified to the above extent.

The action of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Thiruvananthapuram in having revised Clause.5.(b).3 of the prospectus in anticipation of the Government approval is also hereby ratified.
