**SECOND PHASE OF ALLOTMENT**

The Second Phase of Centralised Allotment for admission to MCA Course 2013-14 in Government, Aided, Government Controlled/Private Self Financing Colleges of the State has published on 24.11.2013 (Sunday), 4 p.m. on the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in).

Candidates can access their homepage by entering their application number, roll number and key number to download their allotment memo. The details such as candidate's name, roll number, allotment details, reservations allowed, tuition fees/amount payable in bank etc are available in the allotment memo. The candidate should take a print out of the allotment memo.

Newly allotted candidates should approach one of the designated branches of the State Bank of Travancore (SBT) along with the allotment memo and remit the prescribed tuition fee/ balance fee/amount from 25<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> of November 2013 and get the fee receipt. The list of designated branches of State Bank of Travancore (SBT) is available on the website. Candidates who do not remit the fee/balance fee/amount in the bank on the specified dates will not get admission.

Candidates who got allotment in first or second phase should report for admission to the Principal of the allotted colleges from 25<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> of November 2013, along with the allotment memo, fee receipt and originals of documents specified in Clause 13 of the Prospectus. The candidates who do not take admission in colleges on the specified dates will lose their allotment and will not be considered for further allotments.

Principals of Colleges shall furnish the non-joining report online and its signed printout by fax to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations at 5.30 p.m. on 27.11.2013
