**NOTIFICATION**

1. Applications are invited for the Entrance Examinations for admission to Post Graduate Degree Courses in Ayurveda for the year **2016-17** in Government Ayurveda Colleges at Thiruvananthapuram, Tripunithura, Kannur and in V.P.S.V. Ayurveda College, Kottackal, Vaidyaratnam Ayurveda College, Ollur, Parassinikadavu Ayurveda College, Kannur, Pankaja Kasthuri Ayurveda Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram in the following specialties.

**2. Eligibility for admission:**

- i) **Nativity :** Applicant should be an Indian Citizen. Candidates claiming community or category reservation should produce documents for Kerala origin along with their Nationality proof.
- ii) **Age:** Candidate should not be over 45 years of age as on **31.07.2016**, subject to relaxation of five years in the case of SC/ST candidates and Service Quota candidates
- iii) **Academic Qualifications:** BAM /Ayurvedacharya /BAMS from the colleges having CCIM recognition and BAMS Degree of Universities in Kerala or its equivalent degree recognized by the Universities of Kerala with 50% of marks for theory and practical separately in each subject. But exemption for minimum marks prescribed for admission for MD (Ay) is granted to the students who have passed the BAMS/BAM examination before 1995 from the Universities of Kerala without 50% of marks for theory and practical. Applicants who had completed compulsory internship on or before **31.07.2016** are eligible to apply for the Entrance Examination subject to the production of Internship Certificate from the Medical Council constituted in this regard. **Self attested copy of BAM/BAMS pass certificate must be enclosed with the application form.**

**3. Mode of selection:** Selection of candidates except for the seats reserved under Medical Officers of the Department of I.S.M and the candidate sponsored by the Lakshadweep Administration will be made based on the Entrance Examination to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Thiruvananthapuram. The Entrance Examination will be conducted at **Thiruvananthapuram on 01.10.2016 (Saturday)**. It will consist of Two Papers each of 2 hours duration and with 150 Objective type (Multiple choices) questions each.

**4. Application forms:** Prospectus and Online Application form will be available from **29.08.2016** onwards in the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in). The Online Application procedure is common for General and Service candidates. Candidates seeking admission to this course can apply in the online application form provided in the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations from **29.08.2016 to 06.09.2016, 5 pm**. Separate Applications have to be submitted for General Quota and Service Quota. The Prospectus for this course can also be

downloaded from this website. The application forms and prospectus will not be available from the colleges or from the office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. Candidates should take a printout of the online application submitted, put the signature wherever necessary and should affix a photograph attested by the Gazetted officer. For General Quota candidates, the application fee can be paid through online payment. Those having an Internet banking account, Credit card or Debit card can make use of this feature. General Quota Candidates availing this facility should read and follow each of the instructions given in the website carefully in order to ensure that the payment is successful. General Quota Candidates can also remit the application fee by way of Demand Draft drawn from any nationalized bank in favour of the **Commissioner for Entrance Examinations**, payable at **Thiruvananthapuram**. **General Quota candidates will have to remit the Application fee of Rs.1000/-** (for SC/ST candidates **Rs.500/-**). **The application fee for Service Quota candidates is Rs.1000/-** and can be remitted to the Treasury in the head of account of “ **0210-02-101-99**” and the original chalan should be sent along with the application to the Director of Ayurveda Medical Education, Thiruvananthapuram. The fee for Entrance Examination once remitted will not be refunded on any account. Application forms will not be sold from the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations or from the Directorate of Ayurveda Medical Education.

5. Candidates seeking admission against General merit seat should forward their completed application print out along with the Demand Draft (if payment is not online) and the other required documents to **the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Housing Board Building, Santhinagar, Thiruvananthapuram - 695001**, either by Registered post/Speed post/ hand delivery so as to reach him on or before **07.09.2016 (Wednesday) at 5 pm**. Candidates applying against Service quota should submit their application print out with necessary documents/certificates and the chalan receipt to **the Director, Directorate of Ayurveda Medical Education, Arogyabhavan, M.G. Road, Thiruvananthapuram**, through their controlling officers, so as to reach him on or before **07.09.2016 (Wednesday) at 5 pm**. Belated applications will not be accepted. Commissioner for Entrance Examinations or other officers will not be responsible for any postal delay.
6. Belated, incomplete, defective and wrongly addressed applications will be summarily rejected and no correspondence will be undertaken in this regard. Candidates will not be allowed either to include any information in the application form or to submit any certificates or documents claiming reservation or any benefits, after the submission of the application, under any circumstances.
7. **Admit Card:-** Candidates will have the provision to download their Admit Card from the site [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) with effect from **22.09.2016**. Admit card will not be sent to the candidates by post.
8. **SC,ST/SEBC,OEC candidates in Kerala** should note that they have to furnish Community Certificate/Non-Creamy Layer Certificate in the body of the application form itself. The certificates received after the submission of the application print out will not be considered.
9. The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations will publish the rank list of candidates based on merit as assessed in the Entrance Examination and forward the same to the Director of Ayurveda Medical Education.
10. The selection and allotment of seats including those under Service Quota will be made by the Director of Ayurveda Medical Education, based on various provisions laid down in the Prospectus.
