**ADMISSION TO PG AYURVEDA COURSE, 2018-19**  
**PUBLICATION OF FIRST PHASE ALLOTMENT**

The first phase of Centralised Allotment for admission to PG Ayurveda Course in Government Ayurveda Colleges and Private Self Financing Ayurveda Colleges of the State for the year 2018-19 is published herewith in the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in). The allotment is based on the rank list and online options registered up to 10 am on 22/10/2018. As per the GO (Rt) No. 550/2018/AYUSH dated 22.10.2018, the Government have revised the seat matrix and the allotment is based on the revised seat matrix. Any vacancy arising after the First Phase Allotment will be filled up through spot Admission on 29/10/2018 at Thiruvananthapuram. The detailed notification regarding the Spot Admission will be published later.

Candidates can access their homepage by entering their application number and password in the 'PG Ayurveda -2018 Candidate Portal' provided in the website. Then by clicking the menu item 'Allotment Result' candidates can view the allotment result. The Candidates getting allotment in a College, can download allotment memo. The details such as candidate's name, roll number, allotment details, tuition fees etc. are available in the allotment memo. The candidate shall take a print out of the allotment memo. Candidates can log into their Home Page and then click the Menu Item 'Data Sheet' for downloading the Data Sheet.

Candidates who receive allotment should report for admission to the Principal of the allotted colleges from 23/10/2018 to 25/10/2018 along with the allotment memo and original documents specified in Clause 6.3.8 of the Prospectus. They should remit the complete fees as per Government Orders in the allotted colleges at the time of admission. All the College Principals should approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) at 5.30 p.m. on 25/10/2018.

The candidates who do not join the College on the specified dates, will lose their present allotment and also the higher order options. They will not be considered for further online allotments if any.
