**ALLOTMENT TO PG AYURVEDA COURSES, KERALA-2018**  
**SCHEDULE FOR FIRST PHASE OF ALLOTMENT**

The activities related to the first phase of centralized allotment to Post Graduate Ayurveda Courses for the year 2018 is commenced from **16/10/2018 (Tuesday)**.

All candidates included in the Rank list to be published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can also register their options on the Website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) from **16/10/2018 to 22/10/2018, 10 am**.

The Rank list will be prepared by Commissioner for Entrance Examination, Kerala on the basis of the qualifying marks in All India level Common Entrance test namely (AIAPGET-2018) and subject to other eligibility conditions prescribed in clause (5) of the Government approved Prospectus. In case of a tie in AIAPGET-2018 score, the candidate having high marks in the qualifying examination (BAMS) will be placed higher. If tie still exist the Date of Birth of the candidate will be considered. The allotment will be based on the rank list and online options up to 22/10/2018, 10 am.

Candidate shall have to click 'PG Ayurveda-2018-Candidate Portal' available in the above website. After that the candidates have to enter their Application Number and Password in order to access their home page.

The Candidates can register their options online by clicking the menu item 'Option Registration' available in the home page.

Candidates having defects in their online application can correct the defects through the above website by uploading the required documents before **3 pm on 20/10/2018**.

**The schedule for the allotment is given below:**

<b>22/10/2018</b>	<b>First Allotment</b>
<b>23/10/2018 to 25/10/2018</b>	Payment of Fees and Joining in the colleges
<b>25/10/2018, 5.30 pm</b>	All the college authorities should approve the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System(OAMS).

The list of Ayurveda Colleges/Courses to which the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations makes allotment is provided in the Home page of the candidate. Candidates can give options as per their priority of the Course-College combinations in the option list. **A candidate need only give options to a Course-College combination if he/she is sure to join the course and college, if allotted.** Options registered online alone will be considered for allotment to the courses. Options sent to the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations via Post/Fax/E-mail will not be processed /considered for allotment to the courses.

Candidates allotted to courses, should take admission in the college allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. Candidates who do not take admission will lose their allotment as well as the claims for further online allotments, if any. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances. The candidates are liable to pay admission fee as prescribed by the University concerned at the time of admission.

The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations will be making allotment to the PG Ayurveda Courses in all seats in Government colleges and government seats in Self-financing Colleges.

Candidates allotted to various colleges, should take admission in the colleges and shall remit the fee shown in the Allotment Memo at the college allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances.
