PG DENTAL (MDS) COURSES, KERALA - 2015
FINAL ROUND OF COUNSELING

The final round of counseling to fill up the vacant or newly included State Quota seats in Government/Private Self Financing Dental colleges and the seats expected to be reverted from All India Quota seats in Dental P G courses - 2015 will be conducted on **04.06.2015 (Thursday)**, at the **Government Women's College Auditorium, Vazhuthacaud, Thiruvananthapuram**. The counseling will be manual. All the candidates included in the Rank lists/Category lists prepared and published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations but not joined under All India Quota seats alone are eligible to participate in the final round of counseling. The counseling to the General Quota seats will be based on the various Rank lists and category lists published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

The candidates are directed to report at the venue of the personal counseling at **10.00 am on 04.06.2015**. The candidates appearing for the counseling shall produce all their original certificates to prove their academic eligibility along with the Admit Card issued by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. However a candidate who is holding any seat allotted during the previous round of counseling conducted by the CEE need to submit the Admit Card issued by the CEE and the possession certificate from the concerned Principal of the allotted college that the candidate's original certificates are kept in the custody of the College authority. The vacancies created at the time of allotment will be filled up then and there itself according to merit and eligibility.

The candidates who get allotment will be issued with an allotment memo and the fee to be paid will be shown in the memo. The candidates who get an allotment in the Government Medical Colleges should pay the fees shown in the allotment memo at the venue of allotment itself (Rs 45,000/- for General Quota candidates and Rs.1000/- for SC/ST/OEC candidates). In the case of candidates allotted to a Private Self Financing Dental College, a General Quota candidate should pay an amount of Rs 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) at the venue of allotment itself, as token of having accepted the allotment. The balance amount of fees should be paid at the college concerned at the time of admission. For an SC/ST/OEC candidate, the token amount to be paid at the venue of allotment will be Rs.5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only). However a candidate who has already paid tuition fees to the CEE during the previous round of allotment need to pay only the balance amount, if any, during this round of counseling. The candidates allotted to Private Self Financing Dental Colleges should join the allotted colleges by paying the balance fees on or before 4 pm on 6th June 2015 and the Principals should forward the non-joining report to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by 5 pm on 6th June, 2015.

Important: The candidates who are allotted with a subject in the counseling and who discontinues the course on any reason after this counseling shall be liable to pay the liquidated damages as per Clause XIII(2) of the prospectus.
