PG DENTAL (MDS) COURSES, KERALA - 2015

FIRST ROUND ALLOTMENT CANCELLED AND THE REVISED COUNSELING NOTIFIED

As per the Judgment of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in W.A.No.887 of 2015 dated 1st June, 2015 the First Round of Allotment for MDS Course 2015 is cancelled for considering the Service Quota Candidates who got 40% Marks in the Entrance Examinations MDS-2015 conducted by CEE. In compliance to the order of Hon'ble High Court of Kerala the rank list of Service Quota is revised and published in the website www.cee-kerala.org. During this round of counseling the Government Quota seats and Service Quota seats and newly included State Quota seats in Government/Private Self Financing Dental colleges and the seats expected to be reverted from All India Quota seats in Dental P G courses will be filled in the manual counseling scheduled to be conducted on **05.06.2015 (Friday)**, at the **Government Women's College Auditorium, Vazhuthacaud, Thiruvananthapuram**. All the candidates included in the Rank lists/Category lists prepared and published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations except the candidates who are holding the All India Quota seats alone are eligible to participate in this round of counseling. The counseling to the General Quota seats will be based on various Rank lists and category lists published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

The candidates are directed to report at the venue of the personal counseling at **10.00 am on 05.06.2015**. The candidates appearing for the counseling shall produce all their original certificates to prove their academic eligibility along with the Admit Card issued by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. However a candidate who is holding any seat allotted during the previous round of counseling conducted by the CEE need to submit the Admit Card issued by the CEE and the possession certificate from the concerned Principal of the allotted college that the candidate's original certificates are kept in the custody of the College authority. The vacancies created at the time of allotment will be filled up then and there itself according to merit and eligibility.

The candidates who get allotment will be issued with an allotment memo and the fee to be paid will be shown in the memo. The candidates who get an allotment in the Government Dental Colleges should pay the fees shown in the allotment memo at the venue of allotment itself (Rs 45,000/- for General Quota candidates and Rs.1000/- for SC/ST/OEC candidates). In the case of candidates allotted to a Private Self Financing Dental College, a General Quota candidate should pay an amount of Rs 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) at the venue of allotment itself, as token of having accepted the allotment. The balance amount of fees should be paid at the college concerned at the time of admission. For an SC/ST/OEC candidate, the token amount to be paid at the venue of allotment will be Rs.5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only). However a candidate who has already paid tuition fees to the CEE during the previous round of allotment need to pay only the balance amount, if any, during this round of counseling. The candidates allotted to Private Self Financing Dental Colleges should join the allotted colleges by paying the balance fees on or before 5 pm on 6th June 2015 and the Principals should forward the non-joining report to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations after the date of closing of admissions.

Important: The candidates who are allotted with a subject in the counseling and who discontinues the course on any reason after this counseling shall be liable to pay the liquidated damages as per Clause XIII(2) of the prospectus.
