### Entrance Examination for Admission to PG Dental (MDS) Courses 2015

#### SCHEDULE FOR FIRST PHASE OF ALLOTMENT

The activities related to the first phase of centralized allotment to Entrance Examination for admission to P G Dental (MDS) Courses 2015 will commence from **14.03.2015 (Saturday)**.

The General Quota candidates included in the Rank list and the Service Candidate included in the merit list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can register their options on the Website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) from **14.03.2015** to **18.03.2015, 3 pm.**, after downloading their Key Number.

The Key Number can be downloaded from the website by clicking the link 'MDS-2015 Download Key Number', and entering their Application Number, Roll number, Date of Birth and Password already set by them while applying online for the Entrance Examination. The 'Key Number' is candidate - specific and should be kept confidential by the candidate to avoid misuse by others.

The candidates have to enter their Application Number, Roll Number, Key Number and Password in order to access the home page for registering options.

The schedule:

14.03.2015	Opening of the option registration facility.
18.03.2015 - 3 pm	Closing of option registration facility.
20.03.2015	<b>First allotment</b>
21.03.2015 to 27.03.2015	All candidates who get an allotment shall remit the fee shown in the allotment memo at selected branches of <b>State Bank of Travancore (SBT)</b> .
21.03.2015 to 27.03.2015, 5 pm	All candidates should join the course and college to which they are allotted along with the required documents and Fee Receipt.
27.03.2015, 5.30 pm	Submission of <b>Non-joining report</b> to CEE by the College authorities.

The list of Dental Colleges/Courses to which the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations makes allotment is provided in the Home page of the candidate. Candidates can give options as per their priority of the Course-College combinations in the option list.

A candidate need only give options to a Course-College combination if he/she is sure to join the course and college, if allotted. Options registered online alone will be considered for allotment to the courses. Options sent to the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations via Post/Fax/E-mail will not be processed /considered for allotment to the courses.

Candidates allotted to courses, and who remit the fee as prescribed, should take admission in the college allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. Candidates who do not remit the prescribed fees/take admission will lose their allotment as well as the claims for further online allotments, if any. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances. The candidates are liable to pay admission fee as prescribed by the University concerned at the time of admission.
