**SECOND PHASE OF ALLOTMENT TO POST GRADUATE MEDICAL
DEGREE/DIPLOMA COURSES, KERALA - 2013**

The activities related to the second phase of Single Window System of allotment to Post Graduate Medical Degree/Diploma Courses for the year 2013 will commence from 20.07.2013 (Saturday).

The candidates who have already received an allotment in the 1st phase and joined in the course/college allotted can re-arrange/delete their higher options and also the candidates can register fresh options to the newly added courses, if any, on the Website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from 20.07.2013 to 21.07.2013, 5 pm.

The schedule for the second phase of allotment is given below:

20.07.2013	Website opens for enabling re-arrangement / deletion of higher options and for registering fresh options to newly added courses.
21.07.2013 - 5 pm	Facility for re-arrangement / deletion / addition of options ends.
22.07.2013	Publication of second phase of allotment
23.07.2013 & 24.07.2013	All candidates who get an allotment shall remit the fee / balance fee as shown in the allotment memo at selected branches of State Bank of Travancore (SBT).
23.07.2013 & 24.07.2013 - 5 pm	All candidates should join the course and college to which they are allotted along with the required documents and Fee Receipt.
24.07.2013, 5.30 pm	Submission of Non-joining report by the College authorities before 5.30 pm.
