Admission to PG Medical Courses 2018
Second phase of Allotment Published

The second phase allotment to PG Medical course 2018 in the Government Medical colleges including the enhanced seats, NRI/Community seats in Private Self Financing colleges are published here with.

This allotment is based on the rank in the “Kerala State Rank list revised for Second phase of Allotment” and the online options filed by the General and Service quota candidates from 19-04-2018 to 26-04-2018, 11 am. The allotment list is available in the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations www.cee.kerala.gov.in. To view the allotment result, candidates should log on to the PG Medical 2018 candidate portal by submitting their respective Application number and Password. Clicking on the menu “Allotment result” candidates can view their allotment result page. It is necessary to take a print out of the allotment memo available from 27.04.2018.

Those candidates who receive an allotment on General Merit shall have to remit the fees as specified in the allotment memo to the Commissioner for Entrance Examination. The fee can be remitted using the Online Payment facility from 27/04/2018 in order to accept the allotment. The above candidates should take admission in the respective Medical college from 28-04-2018 to 03-05-2018 before 5 PM along with the documents and balance fee specified in the Allotment Memo.

Conditions of exit after second phase of allotment (GO(Rt) No. 1218/2018/H&FWD dated 12.04.2018)

Those candidates who have joined PG course both in All India as well as State quota on exit, after being allotted to the seats in the second round will have to forfeit 10% of the annual fee if they do not join the course i.e., the exit shall be allowed on forfeiture of 10% of the total annual fee during the second round and if they have joined the course they will not be eligible for further counseling. In case the applicant retains the seats in the first allotment and he/she is not allotted any seats in the second allotment then this allotment in the first allotment will be considered as equivalent to the seat allotted in second round and he will have to forfeit 10% of annual fee, if he decides to quit before the last date of surrender of seat already allotted.

All the college authorities should approve the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management system at 5.30PM on 03-05-2018.
