### **ALLOTMENT/ADMISSION TO PG MEDICAL COURSES-2020**

### **Re-opening of application submission facility following Lowering of the Minimum Qualifying Percentile**

The NEET-PG-2020 minimum qualifying percentiles has been lowered by the National Board of Examinations as per the Letter no. V.11012/15/2020/-MEP dated 14<sup>TH</sup> July 2020, MoHFW as shown in the table below.

Category	Revised Minimum Qualifying Criteria (as directed by MoHFW)	Revised Cut off Score
General	30 <sup>th</sup> Percentile	275
SC/ST/OBC (including PwD oF SC/ST/OBC)	20 <sup>th</sup> Percentile	230
Persons with Disability(UR)	25 <sup>TH</sup> Percentile	252

The online application submission facility based on revised minimum qualifying criteria for PGM-2020 course in Government and Self-financing Medical Colleges in Kerala will be opened from **16/07/2020 to 21/07/2020, 3 pm**. In online application submission, those candidates who are newly qualified as per the revised qualification only can submit applications.

Category	Eligibility for Applying Online as per Revised Minimum Qualifying Criteria
General	Between 30 <sup>th</sup> Percentile and 50 <sup>th</sup> percentile
SC/ST/OBC (including PwD of SC/ST/OBC)	Between 20 <sup>th</sup> Percentile and 40 <sup>th</sup> percentile
Persons with Disability (UR)	Between 25 <sup>th</sup> Percentile and 45 <sup>th</sup> percentile

**Similarly those candidates who claim for any community reservation with percentile higher than 40<sup>th</sup> percentile and lower than 50<sup>th</sup> percentile and those candidates in PwD category with percentile higher than 45<sup>th</sup> percentile and lower than 50<sup>th</sup> percentile will be considered as General Candidates even though they submit the required certificates and documents in proof of their claim online . Such candidates had already been given a chance to apply under the said reserved category by uploading the required documents before 31.05.2020.**

Those candidates who have already applied for the course ,i.e., who have completed steps of applying online till 'Fill application' of their online application need not apply again, and they can avail the facility to complete the remaining steps later. Such candidates will be considered for lower qualifying percentiles if they are eligible as per the new criteria and conditions as laid down by the authority.

Candidates can avail the facility of application submission through the link '**PG Medical 2020 - Re-Opening Online Application**' and should complete the online submission of application and upload the required documents within the deadline. Those candidates who wish to apply in Community/Minority quota/NRI seats in self-financing dental Colleges should also upload the certificates from the village officer concerned. The application facility is hosted in the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in). Newly qualified candidates, who find a place in the rank list, can participate in the remaining phases of allotment subject to the condition that none of the allotments/admission carried out in the previous allotment is disturbed.
