Allotment to MSc. Nursing Course 2017-18 Online Options Invited

The Centralised Allotment Process for admission to PG Nursing (MSc. Nursing) Course in the five Government Nursing Colleges, 43 Private Self-financing Nursing Colleges and one Co-operative Nursing college of the State for the academic year 2017-18 commences on **16.09.2017 (Saturday)**.

All candidates (including Service Quota) candidates included in the rank list can register their options online through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from **16.09.2017 to 19.09.2017, 5 PM**. [See Clause 12 of the Prospectus]. Candidate may enter their Application Number & Roll Number in the link ' PG Nursing 2017 - Candidate Portal' provided in the above website to log on to their home page. Then by clicking the menu item 'Option Registration', candidates can register their options online. The first allotment based on the online options received upto 5pm on 19.09.2017 will be published on 21.09.2017. Candidates who get allotment shall have to join the allotted colleges on 22.09.2017 or 23.09.2017.

The schedule for the first phase of allotment is given below:

16.09.2017	Website opens for Option Registration
19.09.2017, 5 pm	Time for Option Registration ends
21.09.2017	1st Phase Allotment Publication
22.09.2017 to 23.09.2017	Students to join the allotted colleges
23.09.2017, 5.30 pm	To submit final admitted list by Principals to the office of CEE through Online Admission Management System (OAMS)

The list of Nursing Colleges / Courses to which the Commissioner for Entrance Examination makes allotment is provided in the home page of the candidate. Candidates can give options as per their priority of the Course- College combinations in the option list. A candidate need only give options to a Course -College combinations if he / she is sure to join the course and college, if allotted. Candidates who fail to register their options online will not be considered for allotment under any circumstances. Options submitted to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by Fax/Post/Hand delivery will not be processed or considered on any account for the allotment of seats.

★ SC /ST/OEC candidates are exempted from payment of fees.

Candidates allotted to various colleges, should take admission in the colleges and shall remit the fee shown in the Allotment Memo at the college allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances.

Candidates who receive allotment should have attained the eligibility for admission as per Clause 7 of the Prospectus at the time of admission.

Documents to be produced at the time of admission

- 1) Allotment memo issued by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- 2) SSLC or any relevant school records/birth certificate/ other valid document to prove date of birth.
- 3) Original Mark list and Pass Certificate of the qualifying examination.
- 4) Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate from the institution where the Candidate studied last.
- 5) Originals of all uploaded documents / certificates
- 6) Permanent Registration certificate from Kerala Nurses & Midwives Council.
- 7) Experience certificate
- 8) Candidate who passed their qualifying examination from Universities/Boards outside the state shall produce an Eligibility Certificate from KUHS, to the effect that the qualifying examination has been recognised by the University.
- 9) Order of relief from the Institution where they are working (in the case of service candidates)
- 10) Required bond duly filled up and signed by the candidate and sureties

Candidates who do not take admission within the specified dates shall lose their allotment as well as their further claims in the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP).
