ORDER

As per the letter read above, the Director of Medical Education has reported that out of the 7 seats in M.Ch Thoracic Surgery, 6 seats were earmarked for General Merit Quota and one seat under Health Services Quota (HSQ). But there is only one eligible Lecturer in Cardiothoracic Department at Government Medical College, Kottayam having Superspeciality Degree. Hence the Director of Medical Education has requested to earmark one seat under Medical Education Services Quota(MESQ). Similarly out of 20 seats in DM Cardiology Course, 5 seats each were earmarked for MESQ and HSQ and 10 seats for General Merit Quota. The Director of Medical Education has reported that there are only 3 Lecturers in Medical Education Services with out having Superspeciality Degree qualification. Hence the Director of Medical Education has requested to change the seat distribution for DM Cardiology course, earmarking only 3 seats for MESQ.

The Director of Medical Education has also reported that as per the Prospectus for Admission to PG Superspeciality Courses 2013 approved vide Government Order read above, the PG Degree qualification required for applying to DM Cardiology course were General Medicine/ Paediatrics. The Medical Council of India has amended the eligibility condition by including MD Respiratory Medicine along with MD General Medicine/MD Paediatrics. Hence the Director of Medical education has requested to issue necessary orders.

Government have examined the case in detail and are pleased to issue the following orders.

The seat distribution for M.Ch Thoracic Surgery will be 5 seats for General Merit, 1 seat for MES Quota and 1 seat for Health Services Quota. The seat distribution for DM Cardiology Course will be 12 seats for General Merit, 3 seats for MES Quota and 5 seats for Health Services Quota.

The subjects in which P.G Degree qualification is necessary for admission to DM Cardiology as given in Clause 3.2.2 is modified as General Medicine/Paediatrics/Respiratory Medicine.


The Government Order read above is modified to the above extent.
