ALLOTMENT TO ENGINEERING / MEDICAL COURSES - 2008

The allotment to various Professional Degree Colleges in the State has been published in the website at www.cee.kerala.gov.in/capresult2008. The details of allotment will be available in the home page of the candidates. Candidates have to remit the fee, mentioned in the home page, in selected branches (*list available in the website*) of the State Bank of Travancore (SBT) on **1st or 2nd September, 2008**.

Candidates who remit fee have to take admissions at the respective colleges along with the documents specified in the Prospectus, **between 02.09.2008 and 04.09.2008**. Candidates who have already joined for MBBS course in Government Medical Colleges and who have received allotment now, on the basis of higher option, have to report and take admission in the newly allotted colleges. Candidates allotted to different Engineering courses have to join the respective colleges as per the date and time given below:

The candidates will lose their allotment and higher order options, if they fail to remit the required fee or fail to join the college allotted to them in the specified time.

Classes to all courses will commence on **05.09.2008**.

Those candidates who are satisfied with the present allotment can cancel their higher order options. Candidates who wish to retain their higher order options will

have the facility to re-arrange their higher order options, if necessary, by visiting the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in/keam between **05.09.2008** and **08.09.2008 (5 pm)**.

The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations will not be making further allotments to Engineering and Nursing courses in Private Self-financing Colleges. Allotment will be continued to all Government, Government aided and Government controlled self-financing colleges and to all Private Self-financing Colleges except Engineering and Nursing.

Candidates who have paid their fee and allotted to Nursing / B.Pharm. / MLT / BPT courses in different institutions under the School of Medical Education of the Mahatma Gandhi University have to report at the **School of Medical Education, Main Centre, Gandhi Nagar, Near Medical College Hospital, Kottayam** between **02.09.2008** and **04.09.2008**.

Those candidates desirous of cancelling their present allotment have to download the format available in the website www.cee-kerala.org. The downloaded form should be filled and recommended by the Principal concerned and sent to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations **before 5 pm on 10.09.2008**. The allotment of such candidates and their higher order options in that particular stream will get cancelled. Requests for cancellation of allotments received through fax will not be considered under any circumstances.

The Principals of all institutions should send the list of '**non-joining**' candidates **by fax** to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations **before 5 pm on 05.09.2008** itself.
