

## NOTIFICATION ALLOTMENT TO INTEGRATED FIVE YEAR LL.B COURSE 2020-21 FIRST PHASE OF ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED

The First Phase of Centralised Allotment (CAP) for admission to Integrated Five Year LL.B Course in 4 Government Law Colleges and 7 Private Self-financing Law Colleges of the State for the year 2020-21 is published herewith in the website <a href="https://www.cee.kerala.gov.in">www.cee.kerala.gov.in</a>. The allotment is based on the online options registered by candidates up to 3.00 Pm on 15.08.2020.

Candidates can access their homepage by entering their Application number, and Password in the 'Integrated Five Year LL.B 2020- Candidate Portal' provided in the above website. Then by clicking the menu item 'Allotment Result', candidates can view their Allotment details. Thereafter by clicking on the link 'Payment of Fee and Virtual admission', the candidates can remit the fees, as specified in the candidate portal, to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by way of Online Payment and can take admission virtually. Those who complete the remittance of fee will be provided with a Virtual Admission Slip. By generating the Virtual admission slip, the candidates can confirm that their virtual admission process is complete. The SC/ST/OEC candidates who have got any allotment in the first phase shall have to pay a token fee of Rs.500/- to ensure their virtual admission. But if the candidates under these categories fail to prove their claim, they will be liable to pay the tuition fee fixed for general candidates. The candidates are directed to complete the process of virtual admission before 26.08.2020, 4.00 pm The allotted candidates who do not take Virtual Admission before the time specified will lose their present allotment as well as all the options. The balance tuition fee, if any, should be remitted at the allotted college at the time of physical joining as per the allotment received by the candidate at that phase.

Those candidates, who get an allotment in this phase are instructed to ensure their seats through virtual admission only. No physical joining is necessary at this phase of allotment. Candidates who complete the virtual admission process will have to go through the physical admission process at the concerned colleges after the second phase of allotment as per the allotment received in that phase. The details and schedule of second phase of allotment will be notified later.

Note: 1. In Government Law colleges, additional seats will be included in the subsequent allotments as and when sanctioned by Government.

2. Allotment of seats for Economically Weaker Sections in General category (EWS) and Sports quota seats are not included in this phase.
