ORDER

The agreement between Kerala Private Medical College Managements Association and Government is yet to be finalised due to some demands raised by the Association regarding allocation of seats under Management Quota. However the mode of admission and fee structure proposed to the merit seats is not under dispute. As per the letter read above, the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations has intimated that unless orders are issued regarding allocation of seats under merit quota in the Self Financing Medical Colleges, the allotment will get further delayed to seats in Government Medical Colleges and Government Merit seats in Private Medical Colleges.

In the circumstances, orders are issued regarding allocation of merit seats in the following Self Financing Medical Colleges and sanction is accorded to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations for including the colleges for allotment of students for admission to MBBS Course 2012-2013, subject to the terms and conditions specified below.

- 2.Sree Gokulam Medical College & Research foundation, Venjaramoodu, Thiruvananthapuram
- 3.SUT Academy of Medical Sciences, Vattappara, Thiruvananthapuram
- 4.KMCT Medical College, Kozhikode
- 5.Azeezia Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Meeyyannoor, Kollam
- 6.Travancore Medical College, Kollam
- 7.Sree Narayana Institute of Medical Sciences, Ernakulam
- 8.Malabar Medical College Hospital & Research Centre, Kozhikode
- 9.MES Medical College, Perinthalmanna, Malappuram
- 10.Karuna Medical College, Vilayodi, Palakkad,
- 11.Kannur Medical College, Kannur

2. Terms and Conditions: -

1. 50% of the total seats in the Self Financing Medical Colleges mentioned above will be filled up by the managements as allotted by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE) from the list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations on the basis of merit and in accordance with reservation principles followed by Government from time to time, subject Clauses 2 and 3 below.

2. In each of the above colleges, 30% seats out of the above 50% seats will be filled up by the Government from the list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by the students belonging to the community which established the college.
3. To Dr. Somervell Memorial CSI Medical College, Karakonam, the Government shall allot 30% out of the 50% seats agreed to be filled up by the Government i.e., 15 students, from among the students belonging to the minority backward community concerned on the basis of their *interse* merit from the rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. While allotting such students to the Dr. Somervell Memorial C.S.I Medical College, Karakonam, it shall be ensured that 13 (thirteen) candidates shall be those belonging to SIUC – South Kerala Diocese (other than Scheduled Caste Converted Christians of the South Kerala Diocese) having SIUC certificate and 2 (two) students shall be Scheduled Caste Converted Christians belonging to SIUC SKD having SIUC-SKD Certificate. SIUC – South Kerala Diocese status shall be proved/ established by certificate issued by the Bishop, South Kerala Diocese, duly endorsed by the appropriate Revenue authority. In the absence of eligible SIUC – SKD and SC Converted to SIUC – SKD candidates, such seats shall be filled by the Government from the said minority backward community from the students in other areas in the State.
 - 3(a). 30% out of the 50% seats agreed to be filled up by the Government i.e., 15 students in the MES Medical College, Perinthalmanna shall be made from the students belonging to Muslim community on the basis of their *interse* merit in the rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
 - 3(b). 30% out of the 50% seats agreed to be filled up by the Government i.e., 15 students in the Kannur Medical College shall be made from the students belonging to Muslim community on the basis of their *interse* merit in the rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
 - 3(c). 30% out of the 50% seats agreed to be filled up by the Government i.e., 15 students in the Karuna Medical College shall be made from the students belonging to Muslim community, on the basis of their *interse* merit in the rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
 - 3(d). 30% out of the 50% seats agreed to be filled up by the Government i.e., 15 students in the KMCT Medical College shall be made from the students belonging to Muslim community on the basis of their *interse* merit in the rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
 - 3(e). 30% out of the 50% seats agreed to be filled up by the Government i.e., 15 students in the SUT Medical College shall be made from the students belonging to Hindu community on the basis of their *interse* merit in the rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
 - 3(f). 30% out of the 50% seats agreed to be filled up by the Government i.e., 15 students in the Azeezia Medical College shall be made from the students belonging to Muslim community, on the basis of their *interse* merit in the rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations..

- 3(g). 30% out of the 50% seats agreed to be filled up by the Government i.e., 15 students in the Travancore Medical College shall be made from the students belonging to Muslim community, on the basis of their *interse* merit in the rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- 3(h). 30% out of the 50% seats agreed to be filled up by the Government i.e., 15 students in the Sree Narayana Institute of Medical Sciences shall be made from the students belonging to Ezhava/Thiyya community on the basis of their *interse* merit in the rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- 3(i). 30% out of the 50% seats agreed to be filled up by the Government i.e., 22 students in the Sree Gokulam Medical College shall be made from the students belonging to Ezhava/Thiyya community on the basis of their *interse* merit in the rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- 3(j). 30% out of the 50% seats agreed to be filled up by the Government i.e., 22 students in the Malabar Medical College shall be made from the students belonging to Ezhava/Thiyya community on the basis of their *interse* merit in the rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- 3(k). In the absence of eligible candidates as per paras 3, 3(a) to 3(j) as above, such seats shall be filled by the Government from the said community in the manner followed by the Government in filling up of Government Quota seats from the rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
4. The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations shall furnish the list of the students to be admitted in the college by the Management concerned and the Management shall admit the students specified in the list. The students in the list will be given specific instructions as to the date and time of presentation before the college for admission, the amount of fees to be paid and the record to be submitted at the time of admission. The Management concerned shall admit the students who have complied with the instructions as certified by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. The CEE shall furnish such list on or before the 20th day of September 2012.
5. If any student is not admitted by the management concerned for specific defects or for reasons to be recorded in writing, it shall intimate the Government the defects or reasons as the case may be and the Government shall rectify the defects or state the reasons for accepting the list or furnish a revised list which the management concerned shall accept and admit the students accordingly following the above procedures but in any case not later than 5 pm on 20th September 2012. The management concerned shall be entitled to fill those seats still remaining unfilled after 20th September 2012. The Government shall not have any claim over such seats after 20th September 2012 and the forfeited seats shall not be brought forward to succeeding year for compensation.

6. The annual fees for the 50% Government Merit Quota seats shall be the following, during the entire course period.

a) 14% of candidates from among those allotted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations in each institution coming under BPL families as per Kerala State norms irrespective of rank or category need only pay an annual tuition fee of ₹25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only). If enough number of candidates belonging to BPL category as above are not available, the balance number of candidates will be allowed concessional fees of ₹25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) per annum to be selected from among those allotted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations in each institution from those having lower family income, irrespective of rank or category. However SC/ST category of candidates, who already enjoy fee concession benefits, will not be considered for the above purpose. In addition, 26% of candidates who have been allowed SEBC status by the Commissioner for Entrance Examination in each institution shall also pay an annual tuition fee of ₹ 25, 000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only). They will be selected on the basis of the rank. However, if the required number of SEBC candidates is not available among the students allotted by the CEE in the institution, the remaining number of candidates will be selected from among the general category on the basis of income, irrespective of rank or category with the total number of SEBC students eligible for concessional fee not exceeding 26% as above.

b) The same principle as explained in Clause (a) is applicable to the minority institutions also.

c) The fee benefits will be granted only after the closure of allotments to Private Self financing Medical Colleges. Hence candidates (except SC/ST) allotted to these institutions under Government Merit quota will have to remit the fee of ₹ 1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand only) provisionally at the time of the allotment. The Commissioner for Entrance Examination will refund the balance amount to the candidates who will become eligible for fee benefits after the completion of the allotment process, based on the verification of income certificate to be produced by them.

d) Annual fee for SC/ST students shall be paid by the Government to the concerned college, at the rate of uniform fees fixed by the Government.

7. The annual fees fixed as above shall be the complete tuition fee. However the management concerned shall be entitled to collect such other fees payable by the management including University fees, Government fees, Medical Council of India fees, transportation charges, examination conducting charges, establishment charges etc, which shall be specifically listed out and published each year during the entire course of study. The managements concerned shall not collect any amount from any students so admitted, other than those specified above.

8. The management concerned will ensure that no consideration in cash or kind other than those specified above shall be received, accepted or collected in any form whatsoever from any student admitted to the college. It shall be the

liability of the Association/Managements concerned to redress complaints from the students, parents or interested parties on any matter other than those covered by the terms and conditions as above.

9. The Government shall arrange to provide PHC/CHC facilities and ensure supply of cadavers required for the member colleges of the association mentioned above as per the norms fixed by the Government to the colleges,
10. The Management will be free to execute appropriate Service bond from the students admitted under Government quota, except SC/ST students, for a period not exceeding one year, on similar terms as the Bond executed by the students admitted in Government medical colleges.
- 11 The Management shall be entitled to collect uniform tuition fees not less than ₹ 3,75,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Seventy Five Thousand Only) excluding those admitted under NRI quota in the event of the fee structure mentioned in Clause 6 above are declared to be void or not enforceable by the Courts or any authority competent to declare so.
