CENTRALIZED ALLOTMENT TO MEDICAL(EXCEPT MBBS/BDS) & ALLIED COURSES (Last phase of allotment to Private Self Financing Ayurveda, Siddha and Unani colleges) ONLINE OPTION CONFIRMATION IS MANDATORY

The activities related to the Centralized Allotment Process for Medical (except MBBS/BDS) and Allied Courses [Agriculture, Forestry, Veterinary & Fisheries] -2016 begins on 21.10.2016.

The Candidates who want to be considered for this allotment shall have to log into their Home Page and confirm their options by clicking the 'Confirm' button available therein. After Online Option Confirmation, the candidates can re-arrange /delete their existing higher order options and also register fresh options to the newly added Courses/Colleges from 21.10.2016, 2 pm to 23.10.2016, 4 pm, through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. On the basis of options received upto 4 pm on 23.10.2016, the online allotment to Medical (except MBBS/BDS) & Allied Courses will be published at 9 pm on 23.10.2016. Candidates who receive allotment shall have to take a printout of their allotment memo and remit the fee/ balance fee payable to the CEE, in one of the designated branches of the State Bank of Travancore (SBT) or by way of online payment on any date from 24.10.2016 to 25.10.2016. The list of designated branches of SBT is available on the website. After remitting the fee/balance fee, the candidates should join the course/college allotted before 5 pm on 25.10.2016.

Those who do not perform Online Option Confirmation will not be considered for the allotment to Medical(except MBBS/BDS) & Allied Courses [Agriculture, Forestry, Veterinary & Fisheries] and also their higher options in these courses will not be available in the subsequent phases. However his/her existing allotment shall be retained.

^{**}Candidates seeking admission to BUMS (Kamil-E-Tib-Wa-Jarahat) course must have passed Higher Secondary examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala, or examinations recognised equivalent thereto, with 50% aggregate marks in the subjects Physics, Chemistry and Biology and 50% marks in Biology separately and (a) the candidate should have passed 10th or 12th standard with Urdu or Arabic or Persian language as a subject or (b) pre-Tib examination of one year duration.

Token Deposit:

Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC Community category and those having benefit as per G.O. (MS) No.25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005, have to remit Rs. 1000/- as token of having accepted the allotment:

The candidates getting allotment are liable to remit the fee fixed by the Fee Regulatory Committee if the fee fixed on the basis of agreement between Government and Self-financing Managements is not approved by the Hon'ble Court or any competent authority.

Important: The Allotment to be published on 23.10.2016 is the last phase of allotment to Private Self Financing Ayurveda, Siddha and Unani colleges. Hence the students who get allotment in such colleges should invariably join the colleges allotted, before 5 pm on 25.10.2016. Otherwise they are liable to pay the Liquidated Damages as per clause 12.2.4 (c) of the Prospectus for KEAM-2016.

Candidates admitted in MBBS/BDS courses in Govt./ Govt. Controlled/ Private Self Financing Colleges can accept the new allotment to Medical & Allied Courses only after paying the liquidated damages as per clause 12.2.4(a)(iii) of the Prospectus-2016 and orders issued by the Government.

Candidates admitted in Govt./Aided/Govt. Controlled Self Financing Engineering Colleges can accept the new allotment to Medical & Allied Courses only after paying the liquidated damages as per clause 12.2.4 of the Prospectus-2016 and orders issued by the Government.

Candidates admitted in Private Self Financing Engineering Colleges under Kerala Catholic Engineering College Managements Association can accept the new allotment to Medical & Allied Courses subject to the conditions in GO(Ms) No.252/2014/H.Edn.Dated: 07.06.2014.

While issuing Transfer Certificate and other documents to the candidates admitted in other Private Self Financing Engineering/Architecture colleges consequent to the allotment through KEAM 2016, liquidated damages shall not be collected as per GO(Ms) No.155/2016/H.Edn. Dated: 30.06.2016 and GO(Rt) No.1686/2016/H.Edn.Dated: 30.06.2016. But the fees remitted for the year need not be refunded.
