ADMISSION TO PG MEDICAL COURSES, KERALA-2020 First phase of Allotment Published

The First phase allotment to the P G Medical (Degree) Courses for the year 2020 in the Government Medical colleges in the state, Regional Cancer Centre (RCC), Thiruvananthpuram and private self Financing Colleges is published herewith. In view of the pandemic situation in the country due to Covid-19, the rankin the Kerala State merit list and category of the candidates published on 18.04.2020 was provisional. Since the First phase of allotment published is based on the provisional rank list, the allotment published at this phase is also provisional.

The allotment to the NRI Seats available in Azeezia Institute of Medical Sciences, Kollam has not been done in this phase. The allotment to these seats—will be conducted later, subject to the changes to be received from the concerned authority.

The provisional allotment result is available in the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, www.cee.kerala.gov.in.To view the allotment result, candidates should logon to the 'PG Medical 2020 - Candidate Portal' by submitting their Application Number and Password.Clicking on the menu 'Allotment Result', the candidates can view their allotment details.Thereafter by clicking on the link 'Payment of Fee and Virtual admission', the candidates can remit the fees, as specified in the candidate portal, to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by way of Online Payment and can take admission virtually.Those who complete the remittance of fee will be provided with a Virtual Admission Slip. By generating the Virtual admission slip, the candidates can confirm that their virtual admission process is complete.The balance tuition fee, if any, should be remitted at the allotted college at the time of physical joining as per the allotment received by the candidate at that phase.The candidates are directed to complete the process of virtual admission before 04.05.2020, 5 pm. The allotted candidates who do not take Virtual Admission before the time specified will lose their present allotment as well as all the lower order options.

Those candidates, who get an allotment in this phase of allotment are instructed to ensure their seats through virtual admission only. No physical joining is necessary at this phase of allotment. Candidates who complete the virtual admission process will have to go thorough the physical admission process at the concerned colleges after the second phase of allotment as per the allotment received in that phase. The details and schedule of physical joining will be published later.

The SC/ST/OEC candidates who have got any allotment in the first phase shall have to pay a token fee of Rs.1000/- to ensure their Virtual Admission, which will be refunded later. But if the candidates under these categories fail to prove their claim, they will be liable to pay the tution fee fixed for general candidates.

Candidates who have claimed any reservation such as caste or category (including NRI/Minority/EWS) have been provisionally included in the rank list and given provisional allotment. The candidates under NRI/Minority/EWS quota have been considered for allotment at this phase based on the details provided in their online application and on the willingness given by them as per the notification dated 18. 04 .2020. Those candidates who have submitted defective documents to prove their claims, have already been issued memo through their candidate portal. Such candidates should clear the

<u>defects</u> by uploading valid dcuments to support their category and /or nativity claims, before the second phase of allotment.

If the currently allotted seat and /or fee concession granted is based on a claim not supported with the required mandatory documents, such documents must be uploaded within the stipulated time limits before the second phase of allotment or else the seat and / or fee concession, as the case may be, will be cancelled.

The candidates must submit the originals of all the required documents as prescribed in **clause** 4 of the PG Medical 2020 prospectus along with the balance tution fee if any at the time of physical admission.

* The fees in respect of Self Financing Medical Colleges is purely provisional and subject to changes as decided by the Government.
