NOTIFICATION
ALLOTMENT / ADMISSION TO POST GRADUATE MEDICAL
DEGREE COURSES, KERALA -2020

1. Applications are invited from the candidates who have qualified in the NEET-PG 2020, for admission to **Post Graduate Medical Degree Courses, 2020** in the State Quota Seats Government Medical Colleges and Regional Cancer Centre (RCC), Thiruvananthapuram and to the entire seats including minority Quota and NRI Quota seats available in Private Self Financing Medical Colleges in Kerala.

Note: Allotment of seats from the rank list for all courses in Self Financing colleges will be made in accordance with orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India/Hon'ble High Court of Kerala or the orders of the Government of Kerala/Government of India as per the law in existence at the time of the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP).

2. Eligibility for Admission:

(a) Academic: Applicants should be in possession of MBBS degree or provisional MBBS pass certificate recognized by MCI with MBBS qualification registered permanently or provisionally with MCI or State Medical Council and should have completed one year of internship or likely to complete it on or before **31st March 2020**. Admission to such candidate will be given only after obtaining registration of T.C. Medical Council.

(b) Nativity: Applicants should have satisfied any of the following conditions.

- i) Indian Citizens of Kerala origin, Persons of Indian Origin (PIO)/Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) will also be treated at par with Indian Citizens for the limited purpose of admission, provided they execute a bond to serve as Senior Resident for 1 year as envisaged in clause 12.1.(b) of the prospectus. However, POI/OCI candidates will not be eligible for any kind of reservation.
- ii) Candidates who are sons/daughters of Non-Keralite parents, who have obtained MBBS Degree from any of the Medical Colleges in the State of Kerala. But they will not be eligible for Communal/Special/PD reservation benefits.

(c) Age: (i) There is no Upper age limit for admission to PG Medical courses.

(ii) For Service Candidates whose retirement age is 60 years, the upper age limit for getting admission will be 55 years for candidates in Health & Insurance Services and 57 years for candidates from Medical Education service as on 01.01.2020 for Post Graduate Medical Courses(prospectus clause 4-3).

- (d) Qualifying criteria:-** All candidates seeking admission to Post Graduate Medical Degree courses in the State of Kerala for the academic year 2020-21 shall have to qualify the National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test for Post-Graduate Courses (NEET PG-2020) conducted by the National Board of Examination, New Delhi. In order to be eligible for admission in any Post Graduate Medical course in 2020-21, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain a minimum of marks at 50th percentile in the NEET PG 2020. However in respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC), SC-PwD, ST-PwD, SEBC- PwD the minimum marks shall be at 40th percentile. In respect of General- PwD candidates, the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile.

3. Mode of selection:-

The selection of the candidates shall be made from the rank list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Kerala on the basis of NEET PG 2020 rank list subject to satisfying the eligibility conditions as in Clause 4 of the prospectus.

- 4. Submission of Applications and Application Fee:** All candidates seeking admission to the PG Medical Degree Courses 2020 can apply in the Online application form available from 11.03.2020 provided in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and then remit the required fee by way of online payment or by way of e-challan available during the submission of online application. Payment through e-challan can be made in cash at any of the Head/Sub Post offices in Kerala. After remitting the required application fee the candidate should upload signature and all necessary certificates as proof for various claims. **No need to send printout of the application or any documents to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.**

The service candidates should send the printout of the application along with printout of the uploaded documents to the Head of the concerned department before 5 pm of 20.03.2020

Application Fee for General Candidates is Rs.1000/- (Rupees Thousand only) and in the case of SC/ST candidates and those eligible for SC/ST benefits as per G.O.(Ms)No.25/05/SCSTDD dated 20.06.2005 is Rs.500/- (Rupees Five hundred only) Application fee once remitted will not be refunded. The Prospectus can be downloaded from the above website. The application forms and prospectus will not be available from the Medical Colleges or from the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

- 5. Last date and Time for the submission of online application:** All candidates seeking admission to the course should submit the online application along with uploaded documents/certificates mentioned in clause 7.2.4 of the prospectus before 5 pm of 20.03.2020. Late, defective and incomplete applications will be summarily rejected. No correspondence will be undertaken in this regard.
- 6.** The candidates claiming reservation under scheduled caste/Scheduled Tribe/SEBC/Special quota should upload necessary certificates and documents in proof of their claim from the concerned authorities in the prescribed format together with the Online Applications.
- 7.** The admissions to the State Quota seats in Govt. Medical colleges and Regional Cancer Centre (RCC), Thiruvananthapuram and to the entire PG Medical Degree Seats including Minority Quota and NRI Quota in Self-financing Medical Colleges in the state for the year 2020-21 shall be done through a common counseling to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations from State Rank lists which will be prepared on the basis of NEET-PG 2020 rank list.
- 8. Admission under NRI Quota:** The Candidates seeking admission to the NRI quota seats in Self-financing Medical Colleges in the state shall have to upload the following Certificates/documents during the submission of Online Applications as per the GO (RT)NO 375/2020/H&FWD dated 22.02.2020.

“An applicant, who depends upon his/her Father/Mother/Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins)/Husband/Wife/Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) of Father or Mother/Half Brother/Half Sister/Adopted Father or Adopted Mother working abroad” is eligible to apply under NRI Quota. Candidates who wish to apply for the NRI quota seats available in the Private self-financing Medical colleges should upload the following documents:

- (a) Passport copy and Visa attested by the Embassy/Green Card/Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) documents of their respective sponsors. The job of the sponsor should be

mentioned in any of the above documents. The validity of the Visa should be up to the closing date of admission ie 31.05.2020.

- (b) Employment certificate of the sponsor attested by the Embassy/Consulate authorities (In case, the employment of the sponsor is not mentioned in the documents such as Passport copy and Visa attested by the Embassy/Green Card/Overseas Citizen of India (OCI)).
- (c) Relationship certificate of the sponsor and student to be issued by the revenue authorities (Relationship should be established) as per the G.O (Ms) No. 243/14/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014. If the sponsor is the Father/Mother of the applicant, educational certificates of the applicant containing the name of the sponsor shall also be accepted.
- (d) The sworn affidavit from the Sponsor in the stamp paper worth Rs. 200/- should be produced. The same shall also be notarized by the Notary Public, disclosing that the student is dependent of the sponsor and all the expenses i.e. tuition fee and special fee, of the candidate for the entire course period will be borne by the Sponsor.
- (e) The sponsor should be an Indian citizen/Overseas Citizen of India/Person of Indian Origin and relevant document to prove the same.

- 9. Admission under Minority Quota:** Candidates who want to take admission under Minority quota (Christian/Muslim) seats of Post Graduate Medical courses in the Self-financing colleges having Minority status, should upload the Non-creamy layer certificate for Kerala State Education purpose/ Minority/Community Certificate from the Village Officer concerned.
- 10. Admission under EWS Quota:** The candidates eligible for EWS Quota seats should submit the EWS Certificate/documents from the Village Officer in the prescribed format as per the G.O.(MS)No.2/2020/P&ARD from the Personnel and Administrative Reforms (Rules) Department) dated. 12.02.2020. (If applicable)
- 11.** Candidates will be allowed, neither to include any information in the application form nor to submit any certificates/documents claiming reservation or any benefits, after the submission of the application.
- 12. Data Sheet:** Candidates eligible for allotment/admission to the courses will be issued Data Sheet which can be downloaded from the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from the date which will be notified later.
- 13.** The selection and allotment of seats including those of Service candidates will be made by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations through the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) as per **Clause 10** of the Prospectus for admission to Medical Post Graduate Degree courses-2020, approved by the Government of Kerala.
- 14.** Candidates may go through the various provisions of the Prospectus for admission to Medical Post Graduate Degree courses-2020, available on the Official website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations www.cee.kerala.gov.in before filling up the Online application forms.
