**ALLOTMENT TO PG AYURVEDA COURSES, KERALA-2020
ONLINE OPTIONS INVITED FOR FIRST PHASE OF ALLOTMENT**

The activities related to the first phase of centralized allotment to Post Graduate Ayurveda Courses for the year 2020 is commenced from **01.01.2021**. All candidates who have completed their online submission of application alone can register options on the Website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from **01.01.2021 to 05.01.2021, 11 am**. But all those who are included in the Rank list to be published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations will be eligible for allotment/ admission.

POINTS TO BE NOTED AT THE TIME OF OPTION REGISTRATION

1. Candidates can avail the portal for option registration only after the completion of Online submission of application (When the confirmation page is available)
2. Option Registration begins without the scrutiny of the Online application submitted by the candidates. Hence the candidates must strictly note the following points before filing option registration.
 - a) The facility for option registration to all candidates will be available in the portal irrespective of their domicile. The nativity shall be finalized only after completing the scrutiny of Online application submitted by the candidates. The allotment /admission will be based on the Nativity allowed by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations after scrutiny. Hence the candidates must be aware about the conditions regarding Nativity while registering their options. Candidates of Non-Keralite origin will be eligible for admission only to All India Quota seats available in Self-Financing Ayurveda colleges. Candidates registering Online options to Government colleges will lose their options registered to the Government colleges, if their claim for Keralite status is not allowed by the commissioner for Entrance Examinations after the scrutiny of documents submitted in proof of the claim for Keralite status.
 - b) The candidates who have opted service quota in online submission of application can register their corresponding quota seats while giving options. Category list of service quota candidates will be published by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations based on the list provided by the concerned departments. Those candidates who are included in the service quota list published by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations alone will be considered for allotment to such quota seats.
 - c) Fee concession to candidate allotted to the course by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations will be finalized only after the publication of corresponding category lists. The tuition fees displayed in option registration page shall not be applicable to the candidates who will be eligible for fee concession after scrutiny.
3. The option/Allotment/Admission of the candidates will be finalized only after the scrutiny of the online application along with the supporting documents, their Rank, category, Nativity and other related condition mentioned in the prospectus.
4. Candidates should be vigilant while giving options as to where they want to study for the course if they get an allotment.
5. The options to the colleges/courses in this phase will be final. There will be no further provision for registering option to subsequent phases if the colleges/courses available in this phase.

Candidates shall have to click on the link 'PG Ayurveda-2020-online Application' available in the website of Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. There after candidates who have already completed the registration process can log in by clicking the application number and password. If the application submission and uploading of documents are completed by the candidate, the menu item 'Option Registration' will be available in the screen. Clicking on the 'Option Registration ' link will take the candidate to the online option registration facility. In the case of candidates who have not started the online application procedure, they have to start from the registration step.

The schedule for the allotment is given below:

01.01.2021	Opening of the option registration facility.
05.01.2021 - 11 am	Closing of option registration facility.
06.01.2021	First Allotment
07.01.2021 to 11.01.2021, 3.00 pm	Payment of Fees and Joining in the colleges
11.01.2021, 4.00 pm	All the college authorities should approve the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System(OAMS).

The list of Ayurveda Colleges/Courses to which the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations makes allotment is provided in the Home page of the candidate. Candidates can give options as per their priority of the Course-College combinations in the option list.

Candidates allotted to courses, should take admission in the college allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. Candidates who do not take admission will lose their allotment as well as the claims for further online allotments, if any. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances. The candidates are liable to pay admission fee as prescribed by the University concerned at the time of admission.

The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations will be making allotment to the PG Ayurveda Courses in all seats in Government colleges and Government seats in Self-financing Colleges.

Government /Government Controlled Ayurveda Colleges	Tuition Fee: Rs. 15,000 Per Annum
Self-financing Ayurveda Colleges	Tuition Fee : Rs 5,25000 for Clinical Subjects and 2,63000 for Non-Clinical Subjects.

SC /ST/OEC/ Children of Fishermen, inmates of Sri. Chitra Home, Nirbhaya Home, Juvenile Home candidates are exempted from payment of fees.

Candidates allotted to various colleges, should take admission in the colleges and shall remit the fee shown in the Allotment Memo at the college allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances.
