ORDER

Government, as per section 3 of the Kerala Medical Education (Regulation and Control of admission to Private Medical Educational Institutions) Ordinance 2017 (Ordinance No. 14 of 2017) has constituted the Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee, for the supervision and guidance of admission process and for the fixation of fee to be charged from candidates seeking admission in institutions deemed to be Universities or its constituent units there to, imparting Medical Education, other than those promoted and maintained by the Central or State Government and the Private Aided or Unaided Medical Educational Institution affiliated to a University established under the Central Act or incorporated by an Act or State Legislature and their constituent institutions.

2. Accordingly, the Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee as per the orders read as 2nd and 3rd papers above has provisionally fixed the tuition fee for MBBS/BDS courses in Self Financing Colleges in the State for the Academic year 2017-18 as follows;

Sl No	Course & Category	Fee
1	85 % MBBS seats	Rs 5.00 Lakhs
2	15% NRI Seats (MBBS)	Rs 20.00 Lakhs
3	85% BDS Seats	Rs 2.90 Lakhs
4	15% NRI Seats (BDS)	Up to Rs 6.00 Lakhs

- 3. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accept the tuition fee (Provisional) fixed by the Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee for MBBS/ BDS course in the Self Financing Medical Colleges in the State for the academic year 2017-18 as detailed in the table above
- 4. Government are also pleased to accept the decision of the Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee to keep a corpus by setting apart Rs 5 lakhs from the fee fixed for each NRI MBBS seat for giving scholarship to BPL category candidates
