NOTIFICATION

ONLINE ALLOTMENT TO FILL UP THE VACANT SEATS IN MBBS/BDS COURSES AND TO THE NEWLY INCLUDED MEDICAL/DENTAL COLLEGES-2016 ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED

The online allotment to the vacant seats in MBBS and BDS courses in Govt/Govt Controlled Self Financing/Private Self Financing Medical/Dental colleges and the Government seats available in the newly included Medical/Dental colleges is published herewith on the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. Those students who had confirmed their options online within the stipulated time alone are considered for this phase of allotment.

The details of allotment of a candidate such as Name, Roll Number, Allotted Course, Allotted College, Category of Allotment, Fee details etc. will be available on the home page of the candidate. The candidates should take a printout of the allotment memo and produce it before the authorities of **State Bank of Travancore (SBT)** for payment of fee/balance fee. The list of designated branches of **SBT** is available on the website. The fee/balance fee can be paid by way of online payment also.

Those candidates who receive an allotment afresh should remit the fees to be paid to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as specified in the allotment memo at any of the designated branches of State Bank of Travancore or by way of online payment on 19.09.2016 and 20.09.2016 and should join the course/college allotted before 5 pm on 20.09.2016.

The candidates who get a change in allotment than that of the previous allotment should pay the balance fee, if applicable, in a designated branch of SBT or by way of online payment on any date from 19.09.2016 and 20.09.2016 and should join the course/college allotted as per the allotment memo before 5 pm on 20.09.2016.

Those candidates who do not remit the fee/balance fee within the stipulated time and who do not join the course/college allotted within the stipulated time will lose their allotment and also their existing higher options in MBBS/BDS courses. But they are eligible to participate in the Spot Allotment to be conducted for filling up of further vacant seats, if any.

Candidates who are admitted to MBBS/BDS courses through the allotment by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and who want to cancel their admission for the reason that they are not satisfied with their allotment or for any other reason can cancel their admission by obtaining Transfer Certificate and other documents from the colleges concerned before 5 pm on 20.09.2016. Such candidates are not liable to pay the liquidated damages as envisaged in the Prospectus for KEAM 2016. The higher options of such candidates in MBBS/BDS courses will be cancelled. But they are eligible to participate in the Spot Allotment to be conducted for filling up of further vacant seats, if any.

Detailed notification regarding Spot Allotment is published in the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

<u>Note:</u> Candidates admitted in Govt./ Aided/ Govt. Controlled Self Financing Engineering Colleges can accept the new allotment to Medical & Allied Courses only after paying the liquidated damages as per clause 12.2.4 of the Prospectus-2016 and orders issued by the Government.

Candidates admitted in Private Self Financing Engineering Colleges under Kerala Catholic Engineering College Managements Association can accept the new allotment to Medical & Allied Courses subject to the conditions in GO(Ms) No.252/2014/H.Edn.Dated: 07.06.2014.

While issuing Transfer Certificate and other documents to the candidates admitted in other Private Self Financing Engineering/Architecture colleges consequent to the allotment through KEAM 2016, liquidated damages shall not be collected as per GO(Ms) No.155/2016/H.Edn. Dated: 30.06.2016 and GO(Rt) No.1686/2016/H.Edn.Dated: 30.06.2016. But the fees remitted for the year need not be refunded. Helpline numbers: 0471- 2339101, 2339102, 2339103, 2339104.
