NEWLY QUALIFIED CANDIDATES CAN REGISTER OPTION

The activities related to the Mop-up counseling to the Post Graduate Medical -2020 degree commenced from **16.07.2020**. Those candidates who have been included in the rank list to PG Medical courses 2020 published by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can register their Online options from **16.07.2020 to 22.07.2020 till 3.00 pm**. The Online Mop-Up allotment result to the course will be published on **25.07.2020**.

The NEET-PG-2020 minimum qualifying percentiles had been lowered by the National Board of Examinations as per the Letter no. **V.11012/15/2020/-MEP dated 14TH July 2020**. The online application submission facility based on revised minimum qualifying criteria was available to newly qualified candidates from **16/07/2020 to 21/07/2020, 3.00 pm**.

The facility for registering Online options for Mop-Up Counseling will be also be available to newly qualified candidates till 12.00 noon at 24.07.2020. Online Mop Up allotment to the course will be published by considering the rank and Online Options received from eligible candidates. The revised rank /category list including all eligible candidates will be published before the allotment.

The newly qualified candidates who have applied to the course can verify the defects in their Online application in the website. Such candidates can view their profile details by entering their Application Number and Password after clicking on the link '**PG Medical 2020-Candidate Portal**' provided in the above website. Candidates with defective Online application shall click the Menu item '**Memo details**' available in their profile page to view the defects in their application. Such candidates should upload documents/ certificates from the concerned authorities in proof of their claim till **9.00 am of 24.07.2020**. The candidates including those who have already submitted their Online application should verify the details such as Nativity, Nationality and Fees in their Online application and may also rectify their defects. The candidates who fail to rectify the defects in their online application will not be allowed to take part the further procedures of allotment.

In case the candidates get allotment according to their Online Options registered they should compulsorily report at the college and take admission within the stipulated time. The norms related to the Online option registration and the details of college/fees available in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. The candidates should compulsorily go through the notification published on 16.07.2020.
