ADMISSION TO P G MEDICAL (DEGREE) COURSES, KERALA-2020 Second Phase of Allotment Published

The Second Phase allotment to the P G Medical (Degree) Courses-2020 in the Government Medical Colleges in the State, Regional Cancer Centre (RCC), Thiruvananthapuram and Private Self Financing Medical colleges is published herewith. This allotment is based on the rank in the Kerala State Merit List &Category List and on the options filed by the candidates from 02/07/2020 to 07/07/2020. The allotment result is available in the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, www.cee.kerala.gov.in.

A total of 102 All India Quota seats have been surrendered to State Quota seat. The seat distribution of surrendered seats to State Quota seats has been published in the above website.

To view the allotment result, candidates should log on to the 'PG Medical 2020 -Candidate Portal' by submitting their Application Number and Password. Then by clicking on the link 'Allotment Result', candidates can view their allotment result. It is necessary to take a printout of the second phase Allotment Memo. Those candidates who receive a fresh allotment shall have to remit the fees as specified in the second phase allotment memo to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by way of Online Payment or in any designated Head Post Office, by way of e-chalan, in order to accept the allotment. Candidates who receive a change in allotment than the previous allotment shall have to remit the balance fee, if any, to be remitted to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as above.

After remitting the required fee/balance fee, the allotted candidates should report physically for joining the allotted colleges before **4 pm** on **16.07.2020**, along with the required documents specified in the allotment memo. The balance tuition fee, if any, to be remitted to the college should be remitted at the allotted college during admission. The allotted candidates who do not take admission in the respective college before the time specified will lose his/her allotment. All the college authorities should approve the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) at **5 pm on 16.07.2020**.

Conditions of Exit and Guidelines for Mop-up Counselling

- 1. Those candidates who have joined P G Course in State Quota in Round 2 allotment shall not be eligible to participate in the Mop-up Counselling.
- 2. Candidates who have been allotted PG Course in the State Quota on exit after being allotted to the seats in the second round will have to forfeit 10% of the annual fee if they do not join the course. ie, exit shall be allowed only on the forfeiture of 10% of the total annual fee during the second phase and if they have joined he course they will not be eligible for further counselling.
- 3. Candidates already holding a PG seat can participate in the Mop-up Counseling only after surrender of the seat held by them before **16.07.2020**, **5 pm** and forfeiture of 10% of the total annual fee.
- 4. In case the applicant retains the seat in the first allotment and is not allotted any seat in the second allotment, then this seat allotted in the first allotment shall be considered as equivalent to the seat allotted in the second allotment and will have to forfeit 10% of the total annual fee if he/she decides to quit before the last date of surrender of seats.
