### Abstract

Health & Family Welfare Department – Academic – MES Medical College, Perinthalmanna, Malappuram – Fees and admission of students to MBBS course during 2012-2013 – Sanction Accorded – Orders issued.

### ORDER

As per the Government Order read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above, Government have issued orders regarding the allocation of merit seats in the Self Financing Medical Colleges including MES Medical College, Perinthalmanna, Malappuram for allotment of students for admission to MBBS Course 2012-2013. Later as per the Government Order read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above, which was issued in supercession of the orders issued vide Government Order read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above, Government have excluded MES Medical College, Perinthalmanna, Malappuram from the purview of the Government Order read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above, since they have not executed agreement with Government.

Government have held further discussions with the Management of MES Medical College, Perinthalmanna, Malappuram and an agreement has been executed with them as per the paper read 3<sup>rd</sup> above and the following further orders are issued in respect of allotment of seats and fee structure for MBBS Course in MES Medical College, Perinthalmanna, Malappuram.

2. In the circumstances, sanction is accorded to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations for including MES Medical College, Perinthalmanna, Malappuram who has executed agreement with Government in respect of admission and collection of fees from students to be admitted for MBBS Course 2012-2013, for allotment of students subject to the terms and conditions specified below: -

### **3. Terms and Conditions: -**

1. Twenty Three seats (23 Seats) in the MES Medical College, Perinthamanna, will be filled up by the management as allotted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE) from the list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations in accordance with merit and reservation principles followed by the Government from time to time subject to clauses 2 and 3 below. The Management of MES Medical College will surrender 27 more seats from the Management Quota to the Government in accordance with the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated. 25-01-2012 in Civil Appeal No. 1015/2012. These 27 seats will be filled up by the management as allotted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE) from the

list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations in accordance with merit and reservation principles followed by the Government from time to time. The remaining 50% seats (50 seats) will be filled up by the management of MES Medical College, Perinthalmanna. Of this, 15% of the total seats (15 seats) will be filled up by the Management from the Non Resident Indian category.

2. 30% seats out of the total seats surrendered to the Government, i.e. 15 seats agreed to be filled up by the Government in the MES Medical College, Perinthalmanna, shall be made from the students belonging to the Muslim community, on the basis of their interse merit in the rank list published by the commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
3. In the absence of eligible candidates as per para 2 as above, such seats shall be filled by the Government from the said community in the manner followed by the Government in filling up Government quota seats from the rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
4. The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations shall furnish the list of the students to be admitted in MES Medical College, Perinthalmanna and the management shall admit the students specified in the list. The students in the list will be given specific instruction as to the date and time of presentation before the college for admission, the amount of fees to be paid, and the records to be submitted at the time of admission. The management shall admit the students who have complied with the instructions as certified by the Government. The Government shall furnish the final allotment list of students to be admitted in MES Medical College on or before the 20th day of September 2012.
5. If any student is not admitted by the management for specific defects or for reason to be recorded in writing, it shall intimate the Government the defects or reasons as the case may be and the Government shall rectify the defects or state the reasons for accepting the list or furnish a revised list which the management shall accept and admit the students accordingly, following the above procedures but in any case not later than 5 pm on 20<sup>th</sup> September 2012. The management shall be entitled to fill those seats still remaining unfilled after 20<sup>th</sup> September 2012. The Government shall not have any claim over such seats after 20<sup>th</sup> September 2012 and the forfeited seats shall not be brought forward to succeeding year for compensation.
6. The annual fees for the 50% Government Merit Quota seats shall be the following, during the entire course period.
  - (a) *54% seats [i.e, 27 seats out of 100 seats, which are surrendered by the Management from the Management Quota as per the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal No. 1015/2012 (i.e 28% from BPL families and 26% from SEBC students)] of candidates from among those allotted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations in the institution coming under BPL families as per Kerala State norms irrespective of rank or category need only pay an annual tuition of Rs.25,000/-(Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only). If enough number of candidates belonging to BPL category as above are not available, the balance number of candidates will be allowed concessional fees of Rs.25,000/-(Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) per annum to be*

selected from among those allotted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations in the institution from those having lower family income, irrespective of rank or category. However SC/ST category of candidates, who already enjoy fee concession benefits, will not be considered for the above purpose. The 26% of SEBC candidates (ie, 13 out of 100 seats) who have been allowed SEBC status by the Commissioner for Entrance Examination shall also pay an annual tuition fee of Rs. 25, 000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only). They will be selected on the basis of the rank. However, if the required number of SEBC candidates is not available among the students allotted by the CEE in the institution, the remaining number of candidates will be selected from among the general category on the basis of income, irrespective of rank or category with the total number of SEBC students eligible for concessional fee not exceeding 26% as above.

(b) The fee benefits will be granted only after the closure of allotments to Private Self financing Medical Colleges. Hence candidates (except SC/ST) allotted to MES Medical College under Government Merit quota will have to remit the fee of Rs.1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand only) provisionally at the time of the allotment. The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations will refund the balance amount to the candidates who will become eligible for fee benefits after the completion of the allotment process, based on the verification of income certificate to be produced by them.

(c) Annual fee for SC/ST students shall be paid by the Government to the concerned college, at the rate of uniform fees fixed by the Government

7. The annual fees fixed as above shall be the complete tuition fee. However the management concerned shall be entitled to collect such other fees payable by the management including University fees, Government fees, Medical Council of India fees, transportation charges, examination conducting charges, establishment charges etc, which shall be specifically listed out and published each year during the entire course of study. The management concerned shall not collect any amount from any students so admitted, other than those specified above.

8. The remaining 50% of the seats shall be filled up by the management by the following methods

(a) The Management of the MES Medical College is entitled to fill up 15% of the total seats. i.e. 15 seats in the Non-Resident Indian category (NRI) by admitting qualified students who are dependents of Non-Resident Indians. All these students are exempted from qualifying in any entrance test and can be admitted based on their academic eligibility as stipulated by the respective University.

(b) Out of the remaining 35 seats, 15 seats will be privilege seats and the management shall be entitled to fill up these seats from among the candidates irrespective of their rank in the rank list prepared by the

management consortium for allotment under management quota. In the event of no candidates available in the rank list prepared by the management consortium, the remaining seats will be filled up by management from the candidates available in the rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, irrespective of their rank in the rank list.

- (c) The remaining 20 seats will be filled up by the Management according to the rank of the candidates in the rank list prepared by the Management Consortium
9. (a) Each student thus admitted by the management to the above mentioned 35% seats as mentioned in clauses 8 (b) & (c) shall pay annual tuition fees upto Rs.6,50,000/- (Rupees Six Lakhs and Fifty Thousand only) for which signed and sealed receipts shall be given by the Management. In addition to this the management can collect an amount of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs only) from the students in the category as interest free deposit. It shall be refunded at the end of the course without interest. In addition to the above, the management shall be entitled to collect such other fees payable by the management to the University, Government, Medical Council of India and transportation charges, examination conducting charges, extracurricular and other establishment charges, etc.
- (b) Each student thus admitted by the management to the above mentioned 15% seats in the NRI category as mentioned in clause 8 (a) shall pay annual tuition fee upto Rs.9,50,000/ (Rupees Nine Lakhs Fifty Thousand only) ) for which signed and sealed receipts shall be given by the Management.
10. Each student thus selected for admission shall remit the said amount as mentioned in clause 9 (a) & (b) for the first year of the course and produce a bank guarantee from Nationalised Bank or Scheduled Bank for an amount covering the fee for the remaining four years. i.e for the entire course of study.
11. The management concerned will ensure that no consideration in cash or kind other than those specified above shall be received, accepted or collected in any form whatsoever from any student admitted to the college. It shall be the liability of the educational agency concerned to redress complaints from the students on any matter other than those covered by the terms and conditions of this agreement. Where the second party fails to redress any complaints referred to as above or any matter covered under this agreement, it shall be the duty of the First party to take such steps as required under law to redress the complaint.
12. The Government shall arrange to provide PHC/CHC/Autopsy facilities and ensure supply of cadavers required for the college of the Management mentioned above as per the norms fixed by the government to the Managements which have signed the agreement with the Government.
13. The Management will be free to execute appropriate service bond from the students admitted under Government quota except SC/ST students, for a

period not exceeding one year, on similar terms as the Bond executed by the students admitted in Government medical colleges.

14. It shall be the duty of the first party to submit this consensual agreement before the Admission Supervisory Committee and Fee Regulatory Committee constituted by the State for post facto approval.

15. The management shall be entitled to collect uniform tuition fees not more than Rs.3,75,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs and Seventy Five Thousand only) excluding those admitted under NRI Quota in the event of this consensual agreement is not approved as stipulated in clause 14 above and not operative in its entirety or the consensual agreement or the fee structure mentioned in clauses 6 and 9 above are declared to be void or not enforceable by the Courts or any other authority competent to declare so..0
